
PURPOSE: Appointing members to the Sihasin Fund Subcommittee.

16 **SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY**

17 The Naabik'iyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is a standing committee of
18 the Navajo Nation Council empowered to coordinate all state programs with other
19 standing committees and branches of the Navajo Nation government. 2 N.N.C. § 700 (A)
20 and 701 (A)(4).

21
22 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

23 A. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council established the
24 Naabik'iyáti' Committee's Sihasin Fund Subcommittee through the approval of
25 Resolution NABIAP-20-15. See Exhibit A.

26 B. The Sihasin Fund was established for the purpose of providing "... financial support
27 and/or financing for:

28 1) The planning and development of economic development and regional infrastructure
29 supporting economic development and community development, including such
30 infrastructure as, but not limited to , housing, commercial and government buildings,

1 waterline, solid waste management development, powerline projects, and transportation
2 and communication systems, within the Navajo Nation; and
3 2) Education opportunities for members of the Navajo Nation; and
4 3) Leveraging the Fund by way of guaranteeing loans, match funding, direct funding in
5 part, and other weighted uses of the Fund shall be favored over direct funding in whole.”
6 See Exhibit B, CD-68-14 enacting 12 N.N.C. §2502 and Exhibit C, CD-03-18 amending
7 12 N.N.C. §2502.

8 C. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee's Sihasin Fund Subcommittee is charged to recommend
9 to the Naabik'iyáti' Committee and the Navajo Nation Council "...financial support
10 and/or financing plan(s) for the purposes designated in CD-68-14, enacting Title 12, §
11 2502". See Exhibits A, B,C.

12 D. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee's Sihasin Fund Subcommittee is also charged with
13 presenting a report to the Navajo Nation Council by its Summer Session and shall present
14 a final version for consideration by the Fall Session of the Council. See Exhibit A

16 **SECTION THREE. APPOINTMENT**

17 The Naabik'iyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby appoints the following
18 Delegates to the Naabik'iyáti' Committee Sihasin Fund Subcommittee on the basis of two
19 members from each of the five (5) standing committees of the Navajo Nation Council:

26 **SECTION FOUR. SUBCOMMITTEE TERM**

27 The Naabik'iyáti' Committee Sihasin Fund Subcommittee shall exist until its assigned
28 tasks are completed and shall report its recommendations to the Naabik'iyáti' Committee.
