

BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Authority

- A. All resolutions enacting new law or amending existing laws are subject to veto by the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 1005(C)(10) and (11) and override by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(17).
- B. A vetoed resolution shall first be submitted to Naabik'iyáti' Committee before consideration by the Council. 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(17).
- C. Veto legislation passed by the Navajo Nation Council [is] subject to an override of the veto by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 1005(C)(11).

Section Two. Findings

- A. The Navajo Nation Council on April 20, 2020 approved resolution number CJN-49-20 entitled, "AN ACTION RELATING TO NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; CANCELLING THE PRIMARY ELECTION FOR THE 2020

1 CHAPTER ELECTION; SETTING ONE CHAPTER ELECTION DATE FOR
2 NOVEMBER 3, 2020; WAIVING 11 N.N.C. §§ 3(C) AND 41.”

3 B. The Navajo Nation President vetoed CJN-49-20 on July 2, 2020. Attached as
4 Exhibit A is his memorandum supporting his decision to veto the resolution of the
5 Council.

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7 **Section Three. Override**

8 The Navajo Nation Council hereby overrides the Navajo Nation President’s veto of
9 Resolution CJN-49-20.

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
