19 BE IT ENACTED:

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21 **Section One. Authority**

- 22 A. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council  
23 is empowered to provide legislative oversight on matters involving health, social  
24 services, education, general governmental services and human services, 2 N.N.C. §  
25 401(C)(1).
- 26 B. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is  
27 empowered to exercise oversight authority on matters involving roads and  
28 transportation, communication and utilities, information technology, chapter  
29 activities, economic and community development, rights-of way, public utilities and  
30 housing for the purposes enumerated in 2 N.N.C. § 500 (C)(1)-(8).

- 1 C. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to  
 2 review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation,  
 3 investment and management of all funds and to coordinate and review all fiscal,  
 4 financial and investment activities of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §301 (B)(2) and  
 5 (5).
- 6 D. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review  
 7 all proposed legislation which requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2  
 8 N.N.C. §164(A)(9).
- 9 E. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §  
 10 102 (A).

 12 **Section Two. Findings**

- 13 A. The Navajo Nation approved Council Resolution CAP-35-18, attached as **Exhibit A**,  
 14 titled, "Adopting the Sihasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan  
 15 Pursuant to CD-68-14, As Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as  
 16 Amended: Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 810 (F), 820 (I) And (M) And 860 (C) Relating to  
 17 the Capital Improvement Budget and the Capital Improvement Process."
- 18 B. The Navajo Nation President exercised line item veto authority in Council  
 19 Resolution CAP-35-18, upon Rock Point Chapter's Project as listed in Exhibit D (of  
 20 **Exhibit A**). Number 42, BIA Road Route 8070, Year 1 Funding, \$46,100.00; Year 2  
 21 Funding, \$143,250.00; Year 3 Funding, \$ 643,983.00; for total funding of  
 22 \$833,333.00.
- 23 C. Rock Point Chapter requests the Navajo Nation Council approve the following  
 24 projects to replace BIA Road Route 8070:
