

BE IT ENACTED:

**SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY**

- A. The Law and Order Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 600(A).
- B. The Law and Order Committee is the oversight committee for the Navajo Nation Department of Justice 2 N.N.C. § 601(C)(2).
- C. Each oversight committee shall review and make recommendations to the Budget and Finance Committee concerning the budget in accordance with the annual budget instructions. 12 N.N.C. § 840 (A).

**SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

- A. The Law and Order Committee held a budget hearing and took budget testimony regarding the Navajo Nation Department of Justice's Fiscal Year 2021 Budget. 12 N.N.C. § 840 (A).

1 B. The Law and Order Committee recommends to the Budget and Finance

13 B. The Law and Order Committee requests that the Budget and Finance Committee and

15 General Fund Comparative Summary, **Exhibit B**, Recommended Changes to the  
16 General Fund Budget, **Exhibit C**, Recommended Conditions of Appropriation and  
17 Legislative Concerns, **Exhibit D**, and Recommended Unmet Needs, **Exhibit E**.

18 C. The Law and Order Committee authorizes the Committee Chairperson or Vice-  
19 Chairperson to meet and negotiate with the Budget and Finance Committee on these  
20 recommendations.
