18	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
19	A. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is a standing committee of the	
20	Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 400(A). The committee "serve[s] as the oversight	
21	committee for the Division of Health, Division of Social Services, Division of Human	
22	Resources Department of Diné Education, Division of General Services" 2 N.N.C. §	
23	401(C)(1).	
24	B. The Naa'bik'íyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2	
25	N.N.C. § 700(A). All proposed legislation requiring final action by the Navajo Nation	
26	Council are assigned to the committee. 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9).	
27	C. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C.

## SECTION TWO. FINDINGS A. Ms. Karen Rae Nieto (date of

A. Ms. Karen Rae Nieto (date of birth August 17, 1969) was an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation. See Exhibit "A," *Certificate of Navajo Indian Blood*. On October 15, 2011, upon her request, her membership with the Navajo Nation was relinquished. See Exhibit "B," enrollment relinquishment with the Navajo Nation. Subsequently, she enrolled with the Zuni Tribe (as her father is Zuni). Exhibit "C."

B. Ms. Karen Rae Nieto filed for relinquishment of her enrollment with the Zuni Tribe. On January 27, 2016, the Zuni Tribe approved Ms. Nieto's relinquishment request. See Exhibit "D."

C. Ms. Karen Rae Nieto is seeking reinstatement with the Navajo Nation. See Exhibit "E", letter dated June 3, 2019.

D. Ms. Karen Rae Nieto is Ashijni and is the originally from the Chinle community. Her mother is Navajo.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL FOR REENROLLMENT

Ms. Karen Rae Nieto, is and shall be reinstated, or otherwise reenrolled, as a member of the Navajo Nation. By this action of the Navajo Nation Council and pursuant to the laws of the Navajo Nation, she shall be entitled to all rights, benefits and privileges associated with membership with the Navajo Nation.
