25 NHA-4996-2020, attached hereto as **Exhibit B**, requests the support and
26 endorsement of the Navajo Nation Council Resources and Development
27 Committee to approve the Fiscal Year 2021 Navajo Nation Housing Plan for
28 the NAHASDA Indian Housing Block Grant funding and to authorize the
29 submission of the Navajo Nation Indian Housing Plan by the Navajo Housing
30 Authority on behalf of the Navajo Nation.
