TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO HEALTH, EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICES AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE; REAFFIRMING RESOLUTIONS NABIN-69-18 AND NABIMY-27-19, REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS AND THE BIDEN-HARRIS ADMINISTRATION TO ESTABLISH DIRECT SERVICES ON THE NAVAJO NATION FOR NAVAJO VETERANS

PURPOSE: An action relating to Health, Education and Human Services and Naabik'iyati' Committee; Reaffirming Resolutions NABIN-69-18 and NABIMY-27-19, Requesting the United States Congress and the Biden-Harris Administration to establish direct services on the Navajo Nation for Navajo Veterans.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

3 E. The Naabik'iyati' Committee of the 24th Navajo Nation Council passed NABIMY-
4 27-19 reaffirming Resolution NABIN-69-18 requesting the United States Veteran
5 Affairs Administration to establish direct services on the Navajo Nation for Navajo
6 veterans. *See* NABIMY-27-19 attached as **Exhibit B.**

7 F. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs FY 2018 – 2024 Strategic Plan commits the
8 department to making its electronic and information technologies accessible to
9 individuals with disabilities in accordance with section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act
10 (Title 29 U.S.C. § 794d) as amended in 1999.

11 G. The Navajo Nation hereby request the United States Congress and Joe Biden
12 Administration, to establish direct services on the Navajo Nation for Navajo veterans.

18 Navajo Nation Council attached as **Exhibit B.**

19 C. The Navajo Nation through the 24th Navajo Nation Council requests the United States
20 Congress and President Joe Biden Administration to establish direct services on the
21 Navajo Nation for Navajo veterans.

22 D. The Navajo Nation through the 24th Navajo Nation Council hereby authorizes the Navajo
23 Nation President, the Navajo Nation Speaker, Navajo Washington Office and their
24 designees, to advocate for this request.
