**PURPOSE:** This resolution, if approved, will approve the following appendices to the 2021 Arizona Gaming Compact: Appendix A (Technical and Operational Standards, Specifications, and Regulations Governing Gaming Devices); Appendix C (Surveillance, Security, and Reporting Requirements); Appendix H (Minimum Internal Control Standards); Appendix I (Computation and Auditing of Tribal Contributions); and Appendix M (Standards for Self-Exclusion and Responsible Gaming).

16                    SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- 17                    A. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council  
18                    with the enumerated power to review and continually monitor the programs and  
19                    activities of federal and state departments and to assist development of such  
20                    programs designed to serve the Navajo People and the Navajo Nation through  
21                    intergovernmental relationships between the Navajo Nation and such departments. 2  
22                    N.N.C. § 701 (A)(7).
- 23                    B. Navajo Nation Council approved The Navajo Nation – State of Arizona Amended  
24                    and Restated Gaming Compact (the “2021 Arizona Gaming Compact”), including  
25                    certain regulatory appendices, and delegated authority to “the Naabik'iyáti'  
26                    Committee, upon recommendation of the the Naabik'iyáti' Gaming Subcommittee to  
27                    approve other modified or new appendices to the 2021 Arizona Gaming Compact,  
28                    provided such modified or new appendices are agreed to by the Arizona Department  
29                    of Gaming and the Navajo Nation Gaming Regulatory Office." CAP-19-21 § 3(C).

1       **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

2       A. On July 31, 2021, following a report and recommendation by counsel for the Navajo  
3       Nation Gaming Regulatory Office, the Naabik’iyáti’ Gaming Subcommittee  
4       approved, and recommended to the Naabik’iyáti’ Committee to approve the  
5       following modified and new appendices: Appendix A (Technical and Operational  
6       Standards, Specifications, and Regulations Governing Gaming Devices), attached as  
7       **Exhibit A**; Appendix C (Surveillance, Security, and Reporting Requirements),  
8       attached as **Exhibit B**; Appendix H (Minimum Internal Control Standards), attached  
9       as **Exhibit C**; Appendix I (Computation and Auditing of Tribal Contributions),  
10      attached as **Exhibit D**; and Appendix M (Standards for Self-Exclusion and  
11      Responsible Gaming), attached as **Exhibit E** (collectively, the “Modified and New  
12      Appendices”). The Naabik’iyáti’ Gaming Subcommittee resolution is attached as  
13      **Exhibit F**.

14      B. The Arizona Department of Gaming also has agreed to the Modified and New  
15      Appendices, which have been publicly posted on the Arizona Department of Gaming  
16      website at <https://gaming.az.gov/tribal-gaming/gaming-compact-statutes>.

18      **SECTION THREE. APPROVAL AND ADOPTION**

19      The Navajo Nation hereby approves and adopts the Modified and New Appendices  
20      attached as **Exhibits A through E**.

22      **SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE**

23      This Action shall become effective upon certification by the Chairperson of the  
24      Naabik’iyáti’ Committee.
