17 SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

18 The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is a standing committee of the
19 Navajo Nation Council and as such empowered to adopt, amend, or rescind Plans of
20 Operation for the Department of Diné Education. 2 N.N.C. §§ 400 (A), 401(C)(1).

22 SECTION TWO. FINDING

- 23 A. The amended plan of operation for the Department of Diné Education, Navajo
24 Nation Library is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- 25 B. The Navajo Nation Board of Education passed Resolution No. NNBESE-747-
26 2021 approving the amended plan of operation for the Navajo Nation Library and
27 recommends the Health, Education and Human Services Committee to approve
28 the amended plan of operation. Attached as **Exhibit B**.

1 C. The Department of Justice reviewed the amended plan of operation for the Navajo
2 Nation Library and determined the amendment to the Plan of Operation to be
3 legally sufficient. The review documents are attached as **Exhibit C**.

5 **SECTION THREE. APPROVAL**

6 The Health, Education and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council
7 approves the amended plan of operation for the Navajo Nation Library as set forth in
8 **Exhibit A**.

10 **SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE**

11 This Act shall become effective upon its certification by the Chairperson or Pro Tem
12 Chairperson of the Health, Education and Human Services Committee.

14 **SECTION FIVE. SAVINGS CLAUSE**

15 Should any provision of this legislation, be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation
16 Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the
17 Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those amendments that are not determined invalid
18 shall remain the law of the Nation.
