

18 BE IT ENACTED:

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20 SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- 21 A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to
22 exercise oversight authority over Chapter activities. 2 N.N.C. §500(C).
- 23 B. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review
24 and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment and
25 management of all funds, and to coordinate and review all fiscal, financial and investment
26 activities of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §301(B)(2) and §301(B)(5).
- 27 C. The Navajo Nation Council approved Resolution No. CAP-35-18, titled: "Adopting the
28 Sihasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as
29 Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§
30 810 (F), 820 (I) And (M) And 860 (C) Relating to the Capital Improvement Budget and the

1 Capital Improvement Process.” CAP-35-18 is incorporated herein by reference.

2 D. Section 4(C) of CAP-35-18 specifically provides: “A chapter project, powerline, or waterline
3 project may be changed, including the year funded, or added to Exhibits A through E with
4 the concurrence of the Delegate representing the chapter’s Council District and the approvals
5 of the Resources and Development Committee and Budget and Finance Committee, as long
6 as such project has been certified as construction-ready by CPMD or NTUA and the total
7 Sihasin Funding for the District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67.”

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9 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

10 A. The amount of \$33,198.50 for the Round Rock Chapter “Signage Proposal Project” was
11 approved in Exhibit D to CAP-35-18. The CAP-35-18 Exhibit D showing the Round Rock
12 Chapter Project No. D-37 is attached hereto as **EXHIBIT 1**.

13 B. The Round Rock Chapter wishes to move its Signage Proposal Project No. D-37 from
14 Funding Year 1 to Funding Year 3, and to add equipment purchases to the Project. On behalf
15 of the Chapter, the Division of Community Development - Capital Projects Management
16 Department (“CPMD”) has submitted a Sihasin Project Amendment Certification Form that
17 explains the Chapter’s requested changes. **EXHIBIT 2**. This Form shows the signature of
18 the Navajo Nation Council Delegate for the Chapter, according to CAP-35-18 Section 4(C).

19 C. As required by CAP-35-18 Section 4(C), the Signage Proposal Project has been certified by
20 CPMD as construction-ready and the total Sihasin funding for the Council District will not
21 exceed \$4,166,666.67. In fact, the original Sihasin funding amount of \$33,198.50 for the
22 Round Rock Chapter, as approved in CAP-35-18, will remain unchanged.

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24 **SECTION THREE. APPROVAL**

25 A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves a change to Resolution No. CAP-35-18, Exhibit D,
26 Project No. D-37, by moving the Round Rock Chapter’s Signage Proposal Project from
27 Funding Year 1 to Funding Year 3, and adding equipment purchases to the Project, with no
28 change in the original funding amount of \$33,198.50 as shown in the attached **EXHIBIT 2**.

29 B. The Sihasin Fund may be reimbursed the \$33,198.50 reallocated herein, from funds available
30 to the Navajo Nation from any and all state, federal, or other sources.

1 **SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE**

2 This Act shall become effective pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §2505(A) and CAP-35-18, Section 4(C).

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4 **SECTION FIVE. SAVING CLAUSE**

5 If any provision of this Act is determined invalid by the Supreme Court of the Navajo Nation,
6 or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the
7 provision(s) not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.

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
