18	B. A proposed resolution requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be	
19	assigned to the Naabik'íyátí Committee. 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9).

21	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
22	A. The Navajo Nation Code provides, "[t]he [Executive] Director [of the Navajo Nation	
23	Washington Office] shall be appointed by the President of the Navajo Nation, subject	
24	to confirmation by the Navajo Nation Council, to serve at a negotiated salary and at the	
25	pleasure of the President of the Navajo Nation." 2 N.N.C. §1152(B).	
26	B. The Navajo Nation President appoints Mr. Justin Ahasteen as the Executive Director	
27	of the Navajo Nation Washington Office. Mr. Ahasteen's appointment letter, résumé,	
28	and letter of intent are attached as Exhibit A.
