Purpose of this Legislation:

to approve an extension of the Sihasin funds reversion deadline in CAP-39-18 from May 1, 2023 to May 1, 2028, for NTU to complete its Crownpoint Student Housing project.

20	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
21	A. The Budget and Finance Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council	
22	with the responsibility to "review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the	
23	budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds" which includes the	
24	Navajo Nation's Síhasin Fund. 2 N.N.C. §301(B)(2).	
25	B. The Resources & Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation	
26	Council with oversight authority over economic and community development, and housing.	
27	2 N.N.C. §500(C).	
28	C. The Health, Education & Human Services Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo	
29	Nation Council with oversight authority over Navajo Nation colleges and universities, such	
30	as Navajo Technical University. 2 N.N.C. §401(C)(3).	
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- D. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council that considers all proposed final actions by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9).
- E. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §102(A). As such, the Council may enact or amend resolutions approving funds from the Navajo Nation's Síhasin Fund. Specifically, 12 N.N.C. §2505(A) permits expenditures from the Síhasin Fund upon a 2/3 approval vote of all members of the Navajo Nation Council.

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. In Resolution No. CAP-39-18 (signed into law on May 1, 2018), the Navajo Nation Council approved the Sihasin Fund Crownpoint Student Housing Expenditure Plan, along with \$14,300,000 in Sihasin funds, for an on-campus student housing project for Navajo Technical University ("NTU"). CAP-39-18 is incorporated herein by this reference.
- B. Section 4(A)(4) of CAP-39-18 states:
 - * * * *
 - 4. The funds allocated for the Crownpoint Student Housing project shall not lapse on an annual basis pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820 (N) or otherwise be returned to or deposited in the Síhasin Fund Principal or Navajo Nation General Fund until the earlier of five (5) years from the date of adoption of this legislation or such time as the Crownpoint Student Housing project, as set forth in Exhibit A, is fully completed.
- C. The wording in Section 4(A)(4) means that unexpended Síhasin funds, from the \$14,300,000 approved in CAP-39-18, will lapse and revert back to the Síhasin Fund on May 1, 2023.
- D. The President of NTU is requesting an extension of the reversion deadline of May 1, 2023, in Section 4(A)(4) of CAP-39-18. NTU's President explains the various reasons why NTU has been unable to expend the approved Síhasin funds since May 1, 2018, and will not meet the May 1, 2023 deadline for expenditure of the entire \$14,300,000. **EXHIBIT A**.
- E. NTU is requesting an extension of the funds reversion deadline to May 1, 2028, to give NTU sufficient time to expend the entire \$14,300,000 in Síhasin funds approved in CAP-39-18. **EXHIBIT A**.

- F. NTU has provided project-related documents, including drawings and photographs, for its Crownpoint Student Housing project. **EXHIBIT B**.
- G. The Navajo Nation has determined that approving NTU's requested extension of the Síhasin funds reversion deadline in Section 4(A)(4) of CAP-39-18 is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation.

SECTION THREE. AMENDING CAP-39-18 TO EXTEND THE SÍHASIN FUNDS REVERSION DEADLINE FOR NAVAJO TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY'S CROWNPOINT CAMPUS STUDENT HOUSING EXPENDITURE PLAN

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves an amendment to Section 4(A)(4) of CAP-39-18, as follows:
 - * * * *
 - 4. The funds allocated for the Crownpoint Student Housing project shall not lapse on an annual basis pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820 (N) or otherwise be returned to or deposited in the Sihasin Fund Principal or Navajo Nation General Fund until the earlier of five (5) years from the date of adoption of this legislation or such time as the Crownpoint Student Housing project, as set forth in Exhibit A, is fully completed. so long as such funds are expended or encumbered for the Crownpoint Student Housing project by May 1, 2028.
- B. The approved Síhasin funds shall be used by NTU strictly for the completion of its Crownpoint Student Housing Expenditure Plan approved in CAP-39-18. Síhasin funds shall not be comingled with any other funds.
- C. NTU shall allow the Navajo Nation full access to its financial and other records related to the Síhasin funds it has received under CAP-39-18 and this Action. Such access shall be for the purpose of the Navajo Nation's review and audit of NTU's expenditures of Síhasin funds, and the progress of the Crownpoint Student Housing project.
- D. NTU shall submit written reports, and verbal reports if so requested, explaining the ongoing status of the Crownpoint Student Housing project and NTU's expenditures of the Síhasin

funds approved in CAP-39-18. Said reports shall be provided to the Health, Education and Human Services Committee, the Budget and Finance Committee, and the Naabik'íyáti' Committee by the end of each Fiscal Year Quarter until the Crownpoint Student Housing project is completed, or until all approved Síhasin funds are exhausted, or upon the new May 1, 2028 reversion deadline approved in this Action.

SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Action shall become effective pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §2505(A) and 2 N.N.C. §221(B).

SECTION FIVE. SAVING CLAUSE

If any portion of this Action is invalidated by the Supreme Court of the Navajo Nation, or by any Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the remainder of this Action shall be the law of the Navajo Nation.
