
**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this proposed resolution is to support Arizona House HB 2800.

**WHEREAS:**

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Naabik'iyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered the Naabik'iyáti' Committee to coordinate all requests for information, appearances and testimony relating to proposed county, state and federal legislation impacting the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 700 (A), 701 (A)(6).
- B. The Health Education and Human Services Committee is empowered to recommend and review resolutions relating to education. 2 N.N.C. § 401(B)(6)(a).
- C. The Navajo Nation has a government-to-government relationship with the State of Arizona.

1 D. During the First Regular Session of 2023, Arizona State Representative Matt Gress  
2 from LD 4 introduced House Bill 2800 to the 56<sup>th</sup> Legislature, the text of which is  
3 included in **Exhibit A**.

4 E. The Arizona House Engrossed Summary Sheet for House Bill 280, attached as **Exhibit**  
5 **B**, provides, in relevant part, that “each school district and charter school to increase  
6 the base salary of all eligible teachers and creates Pay Teachers First Fund.”

8 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

9 A. The Navajo Nation hereby supports Arizona House Bill 2800 titled “AN ACT  
10 AMENDING SECTION 15-189.05. ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES:  
11 AMENDING TITLE 15. CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED  
12 STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 15-248.01; AMENDING SECTIONS 15-747  
13 AND 15-903, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-5706;  
14 APPROPRIATING MONIES; RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL,” in accordance  
15 with **Exhibit A**.

16 B. The Navajo Nation hereby authorizes the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council,  
17 President of the Navajo Nation, and their designees, to advocate the Navajo Nation’s  
18 support of Arizona House Bill 2800.
