- D. During the First Regular Session of 2023, Arizona State Representative Matt Gress from LD 4 introduced House Bill 2800 to the 56th Legislature, the text of which is included in **Exhibit A**.
- E. The Arizona House Engrossed Summary Sheet for House Bill 280, attached as Exhibit B, provides, in relevant part, that "each school district and charter school to increase the base salary of all eligible teachers and creates Pay Teachers First Fund."

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby supports Arizona House Bill 2800 titled "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 15-189.05. ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES: AMENDING TITLE 15. CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 15-248.01; AMENDING SECTIONS 15-747 AND 15-903, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-5706; APPROPRIATING MONIES; RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL," in accordance with Exhibit A.
- B. The Navajo Nation hereby authorizes the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council, President of the Navajo Nation, and their designees, to advocate the Navajo Nation's support of Arizona House Bill 2800.
