15 BE IT ENACTED:

16 **SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY**

17 The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is a standing committee of the  
18 Navajo Nation Council and serves as the oversight committee for the Division of General  
19 Services with authority to review, recommend or propose the adoption, amendment or  
20 rescission of its Plan of Operation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 400(A), 401(C)(1).

21  
22 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

- 23 A. The Division of General Services (the “Division”) is established under the Executive  
24 Branch of the Navajo Nation Government. 2 N.N.C. § 1251.  
25 B. The Division currently operates under the Master Plan as approved by GSCS-69-95  
26 with its individual component departments being amended separately.  
27 C. The Division has submitted a revised Master Plan of Operation for the Division of  
28 General Services and is attached as **Exhibit A**.  
29 D. An Executive Official Review of the revised Master Plan of Operation has been  
30 completed with the reviewers marking the revisions as legally sufficient. The Executive

1 Official Review and a copy of the strikethrough/underlined version of the amendments  
2 are attached as **Exhibit B**.

4 **SECTION THREE. APPROVAL**

5 The Navajo Nation hereby amends the Master Plan of Operation for the Navajo Division  
6 of General Services, as set forth in the attached **Exhibit A**.
