B. PUBLIC LAWS 100-297 AND 93-638

1) Public Law 100-297 allowed schools to become tribally controlled schools governed by a Board of Trustees.

2) The Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act of 1975 (Public Law 93-638) authorized the Secretary of the Interior, the Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare, and some other government agencies to enter into contracts with and make grants directly to, federally recognized Indian tribes.
