TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE; REAFFIRMING THE NAVAJO NATION'S OPPOSITION TO ANY MOMUMENT OF CHRISTOPHER "KIT" CARSON BEING PLACED IN THE STATE OF NEW MEXIO, AND SPECIFICALLY AT BOSQUE REDONDO, SANTA FE CEMETERY, OR THE CARSON HOUSE AND MUSEUM IN TOAS

PURPOSE: This resolution, if approved, would oppose any monument of Christopher "Kit" Carson from being placed in the State of New Mexico.

Final Authority: Naabi'kiyati Committee

Vote Required: Simple Majority

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review the proposed resolution in detail.

SPECIFICALLY AT BOSQUE REDONDO, SANTA FE CEMETERY, OR THE
CARSON HOUSE AND MUSEUM IN TOAS

WHEREAS:

- A. Navajo Nation statements of policy are written statements submitted to federal, state or local governments by a Navajo Nation official stating the official position of the Navajo Nation on proposed legislation or other action by that government. 2 N.N.C. § 110 (W). Navajo Nation statements of policy must be reviewed and approved by resolution of the appropriate standing committee(s) and the Navajo Nation Council. See 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A).
- B. The Navajo Nation established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered Naabik'íyáti' Committee to assist and coordinate all requests for information, appearances and testimony relating to proposed county, state and federal legislation impacting the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 700 (A) and 701(A)(6).
- C. The Navajo Nation passed resolution NABIN-44-21, AN ACTION RELATING TO NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE; REQUESTING THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO TO REMOVE THE NAME OF CHRISTOPHER "KIT" CARSON FROM ALL

- MONUMENTS, STATE PARKS, GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS, HIGHWAYS AND STREETS WITHIN THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO. Exhibit A.
- D. NABIN-44-21, outlined the brutal treatment the Navajo people endured under the hand and direction of Kit Carson, and voiced the Navajo Nation strenuous object to any and all memorialization of Kit Carson, including the erection of monuments and the naming of parks, government buildings, highways, roads, etc. in his honor.
- E. The Navajo Nation recently discovered that discussions to place a monument of Kit Carson within New Mexico is being deliberated without tribal consultation. **Exhibit B**.
- F. The Navajo Nation re-affirms their position in opposition of any monument of Kit Carson in New Mexico. The Navajo Nation calls on the State of New Mexico, including all cities, towns, and municipalities within New Mexico, and the Federal Government to cease placement of any monuments of Kit Carson.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby requests the State of New Mexico to immediately remove the name of Christopher "Kit" Carson from all governmental properties, including monuments, parks, highways, streets, etc. in the State of New Mexico.
- B. The Navajo Nation hereby further requests that the United States Federal Government immediately cease using Christopher "Kit" Carson in the naming governmental properties, including monuments, parks, highways, streets, etc.
- C. The Navajo Nation additionally requests the immediate inclusion of tribal consultation regarding the current discussions to place a monument of Kit Carson within the State of New Mexico, specifically at Bosque Redondo, Santa Fe Cemetery, and the Carson House and Museum in Toas.
- D. The Navajo Nation Council authorizes the Navajo Nation President and Navajo Nation Speaker to affirm the Navajo Nation's position of removing Christopher "Kit" Carson's name or monuments from government properties.
