PURPOSE OF THIS LEGISLATION:

To create a new "BRD Fund" (Enterprise Fund) consisting of revenues collected by the Business Regulatory Department from charging fees for business incorporations, registrations, etc.

Revenues currently go into, and stay in, the General Fund, but would go into the new BRD Fund if this Act is approved.

FINAL AUTHORITY and VOTE REQUIREMENT:

The Navajo Nation Council has final authority. A 7/8 vote is required pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820(N)(4).

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20	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY.	
21	A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council oversees the	
22	Navajo Nation Division of Economic Development and the Division's subordinate	
23	departments, including the Navajo Business Regulatory Department. 2 N.N.C. §501(C)(1);	
24	DED Plan of Operation, Section IV(B)(3), as approved in Resolution No. RDCO-055-19.	
25	B. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is authorized to review	
26	and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council matters related to the budgeting, appropriation,	
27	investment, and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §301(B)(2).	
28	C. The Naabik'íyátí' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is authorized to review all	
29	proposed legislation requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C.	
30	§164(A)(9).	

- D. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation with the power to enact positive law of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §102(A) and §164(A).
 - E. Navajo Nation funds may be deposited into approved special accounts. 12 N.N.C. §601(A).
 - F. The Navajo Nation may establish Enterprise Funds, a type of Proprietary Fund as defined in 12 N.N.C. §810(S)(2), for the purpose of partially recovering the costs of government services through user charges. 12 N.N.C. §810(S)(2)(a).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS.

A. The Navajo Business Regulatory Department, under the Navajo Nation Division of Economic Development, routinely collects revenue by charging and collecting fees for compliance with certain provisions under Title 5 of the Navajo Nation Code, as follows:

Navajo Corporation Code (at 5 N.N.C. §3100 - §3425);

Navajo Limited Liability Act (at 5 N.N.C. §360 - §3612);

Navajo Uniform Partnership Act (at 5 N.N.C. §3800 - §3918);

Navajo Limited Partnership Act (at 5 N.N.C. §4100 - §4107);

Navajo Uniform Commercial Code (at 5A N.N.C. §1 - §101-9-507);

Administration of Weights & Measures (5 N.N.C. §2401 - §2410).

- B. Currently, all revenue collected by the Business Regulatory Department is deposited into the Navajo Nation General Fund under the Account: *Business Fees* and the Object Code: *Fees-Nav Corp Code*.
- C. Instead of this revenue remaining in the Navajo Nation General Fund, the Department proposes to use this revenue to cover the costs of its annual operations.
- D. The Business Regulatory Department's operating costs include, but are not limited to: purchases of office supplies; purchases, rentals, or repairs of equipment, furniture, or facilities; telephone, internet, and cellular services; personnel expenses such as salaries, bonuses, fringe benefits, and background checks; consultant services; costs associated with outreach efforts; building space rentals; travel expenses; employee training; photocopying, and other costs.
- E. The Office of the Controller has provided a memorandum dated March 5, 2025 that lists the revenue collected by the Business Regulatory Department in previous years, which money

1	has remained in the Navajo Nation General Fund. EXHIBIT A.
2	F. It is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation to establish a new Enterprise Fund for the set
3	aside of revenue collected by the Business Regulatory Department from its Title 5
4	authorities, to assist in funding the Department's annual operations.
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6	SECTION THREE. ESTABLISHING A NEW ENTERPRISE FUND FOR THE
7	NAVAJO BUSINESS REGULATORY DEPARTMENT.
8	The Navajo Nation hereby establishes the "Business Regulatory Department Enterprise Fund"
9	and approves its enabling legislation as follows:

11	Title 12. Fiscal Matters
12	
13	Chapter 30. Business Regulatory Department Enterprise Fund.
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15	§3201. Establishment; Purpose.
16	A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §601(A) and 12 N.N.C. §810(S)(2)(a), the Navajo Nation hereby
17	establishes the "Business Regulatory Department Enterprise Fund" (hereinafter referred to
18	as "BRD Fund") for the exclusive use by the Navajo Business Regulatory Department under
19	the Navajo Nation Division of Economic Development.
20	B. The BRD Fund is established to provide a source of funds for the Business Regulatory
21	Department's annual operating expenses, and to assist the Department in carrying out its
22	responsibilities under the following Navajo Nation laws:
23	1. Navajo Corporation Code (at 5 N.N.C. §3100 - §3425);
24	2. Navajo Limited Liability Act (at 5 N.N.C. §360 -§3612);
25	3. Navajo Uniform Partnership Act (at 5 N.N.C. §3800 - §3918);
26	4. Navajo Limited Partnership Act (at 5 N.N.C. §4100 - §4107);
27	5. Navajo Uniform Commercial Code (at 5A N.N.C. §1 - §101-9-507); and
28	6. Administration of Weights & Measures (at 5 N.N.C. §2401 - §2410).
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§3202. Source of money for the BRD Fund. 1 A. The BRD Fund shall consist primarily of all revenue collected by the Business Regulatory 2 Department from the assessment of fees upon individuals and entities for compliance with 3 the Navajo Nation laws cited in §3201(B)(1)-(6) herein. 4 B. All such revenue is currently deposited into the Navajo Nation General Fund under the 5 Account: Business Fees and the Object Code: Fees-Nav Corp Code. Upon the Effective Date 6 7 of this Act, all such revenue shall be deposited directly into the BRD Fund immediately upon payment and collection of any/all revenue, and none of the revenue shall remain in the 8 9 Navajo Nation General Fund. C. The Navajo Nation Council may at any time approve further appropriations or allocations 10 into the BRD Fund from any other sources of revenue available to the Navajo Nation. 11 12 §3203. No lapsing or reversion. 13 The BRD Fund shall be a continuing account and no money in the BRD Fund shall lapse or 14 revert at the end of the fiscal year, as might otherwise occur under 12 N.N.C. §820(N) or any 15 16 other provision of Navajo Nation law. 17 18 §3204. Fund Management Plan. A. All allocations and expenditures of money from the BRD Fund shall be in accordance with 19 20 a Fund Management Plan approved by both the Resources and Development Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee, with the Budget and Finance Committee having final 21 22 approval authority. B. The Fund Management Plan shall have attached to it an "Exhibit A" consisting of the 23 24 Schedule of Fees mandated in §3205 herein. C. The Fund Management Plan shall not permit any other entity to receive allocations from the 25 BRD Fund for any purpose. The BRD Fund shall be used solely for the Business Regulatory 26 Department for the purposes stated in §3201 herein. 27 D. The Business Regulatory Department shall present its proposed Fund Management Plan to 28 the Resources and Development Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee within 29 60 calendar days after the Effective Date of this Act. 30

1	E. No money from the BRD Fund shall be expended until final approval of the Fund
2	Management Plan by the Budget and Finance Committee.
3	
4	§3205. Schedule of Fees.
5	A. Fees shall be charged to individuals and entities for compliance with the Title 5 provisions
6	enumerated in §3201(B)(1)-(6) herein. The Business Regulatory Department shall determine
7	the amount of fees and shall prepare a Schedule of Fees to be attached to the proposed Fund
8	Management Plan as "Exhibit A."
9	B. Once approved within the Fund Management Plan, the Business Regulatory Department
10	shall charge and collect fees strictly according to the Schedule of Fees.
11	C. Once approved by the Budget and Finance Committee, the Schedule of Fees shall remain in
12	effect until rescinded or amended by the Budget and Finance Committee after
13	recommendation of such rescission or amendment by the Business Regulatory Department
14	and the Resources and Development Committee.
15	D. The current approved Schedule of Fees shall be made publicly available by the Business
16	Regulatory Department and/or posted on the Department's public website at all times.
17	E. Any rescission or amendment to the Schedule of Fees shall be considered a recission or
18	amendment of the approved Fund Management Plan, and such recission or amendment shall
19	require approval by the Resources and Development Committee and the Budget and Finance
20	Committee, with the Budget and Finance Committee having final approval authority.
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22	§3206. BRD administration; reporting.
23	A. The Business Regulatory Department shall administer the BRD Fund. The Director of the
24	Division of Economic Development and the Resources and Development Committee shall
25	have oversight authority over the Department's activities regarding administration of the
26	BRD Fund.
27	B. On a Fiscal Year Quarterly basis, the Director of the Business Regulatory Department shall
28	provide a written report, with a verbal report if so requested, to the Navajo Nation Council.
29	C. Said report shall include an explanation of all revenue collected and all uses of the BRD Fund

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3	§3209. Amendments.
4	Any portion of this Act may be amended by a simple majority vote of the full membership of
5	the Navajo Nation Council and signature approval of the President of the Navajo Nation.
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9	SECTION FOUR. DIRECTIVES.
10	A. Promptly upon the effective date of this Act, the Office of the Controller shall set up the new
11	BRD Fund financial account for the Navajo Nation, in accordance with the Navajo Nation's
12	usual accounting and bookkeeping procedures for Enterprise Funds. All revenues collected
13	after the Effective Date of this Act shall be deposited into the BRD Fund and shall not be
14	kept in the General Fund.
15	B. The Navajo Nation Council hereby directs the Business Regulatory Department to prepare
16	and present a Fund Management Plan to the Resources and Development Committee and the
17	Budget and Finance Committee, within 60 calendar days after the Effective Date of this Act.
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19	SECTION FIVE. WAIVER OF 12 N.N.C. §820(N).
20	The Navajo Nation Council hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §820(N) to the extent necessary to effect
21	all provisions of this Act.
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23	SECTION SIX. SAVING CLAUSE.
24	If any part of this Act is determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or by a
25	District Court of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the
26	remainder of the Act shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.
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28	SECTION SEVEN. EFFECTIVE DATE.
29	This Act shall become effective upon a 7/8 vote of the Navajo Nation Council, as provided in
30	12 N.N.C. §820(N)(4), 2 N.N.C. §221(B), 2 N.N.C. §1005(C)(10), and 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(17).

The provisions of this Act which amend or adopt new sections of the Navajo Nation Code shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative Counsel shall incorporate such amended provisions into the next codification of the Navajo Nation Code.
