16 SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- 17 A. The Navajo Nation established the Naabik'iyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation Council
18 standing committee, 2 N.N.C. § 700(A).
19 B. “All Navajo Nation public officials, elected and non-elected, who receive gifts, whether
20 intended as a gift to the individual official or to the Navajo Nation, shall record or cause to
21 be recorded such gift with the Ethics and Rules Office.” 2 N.N.C. § 1012.
22 C. “The President of the Navajo Nation shall, for and on behalf of the Navajo Nation, accept
23 or decline gifts of property, including monetary donations, provided that any such
24 acceptance or refusal of a gift of an estimated value in excess of one thousand dollars
25 (\$1,000) shall be with the concurrence of the Naabik'iyáti' Committee.” 2 N.N.C. §1010.

27 SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- 28 A. Navajo Division of Behavioral and Mental Health Services received one hundred thousand
29 (100,000) Revive kits from the Veterans Medical Leadership Council. The total value of
30 the kits is approximately \$3,400,000.

1 B. The Navajo Nation President Buu Nygren accepted the donations listed in Paragraph A.
