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- A. The Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission ("DURAC") was established within the Executive Branch of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §3583; CAP-14-15.
- B. The DURAC shall consist of seven (7) members. "Seven members shall be community members, preferably one from each of the six Abandoned Uranium Mines (AUM) Regions (as defined by the U.S. EPA) affecting the past uranium mining Northern, North Central, Eastern, Southern, Western, and Central, and one selected At-Large Community Representative. These seven (7) members shall all be enrolled members of the Navajo Nation with a background in environmental science, environmental justice, engineering, social science, health, policy making if at all possible." - C. "The Navajo Nation President shall appoint the At-Large Community Representative." *Id.* at sec. VIII(3)(a).
- D. "The President and the Council may, but are not required to, make a public announcement soliciting letters of interest and statements of qualification for the Commission member positions." *Id.* at sec. VIII(3)(c).
- E. "The initial term of the Commission shall be approximately five (5) years. The second term shall begin when a quorum of Commissioners is established, and shall end on September 30, 2029. The Navajo Nation Council may, by majority vote, renew the Commission for an additional five-year term, or for such period as the Council may choose." *Id.* at sec. VIII(1).
- F. Mr. Jonathan Perry has expressed his interest in serving on the Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission and is an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation. Letter of Interest, Résumé and Certificate of Indian Blood are attached as an Exhibits B, C and D, respectively.
- G. The Navajo Nation President appoints Mr. Jonathan Perry to the Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission. **Exhibit E.**

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H. Mr. Jonathan Perry's appointment to the Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission is for the remainder of the second term of five (5) years and expires on September 30, 2029. *Id.* at sec. VIII(1).

SECTION THREE. CONFIRMING APPOINTMENT

The Navajo Nation confirms the appointment of Mr. Jonathan Perry to serve on the Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission as an At-Large Community Member for the remainder of the second term of five (5) years which expires on September 30, 2029.
