17	BE IT ENACTED:
18	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY
19	A. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 401(C)(3), the Health, Education and Human Services Committee
20	has oversight of the Navajo Nation Board of Education, and colleges within the Navajo
21	Nation, and has the authority to review and recommend resolutions relating to education
22	in accordance with 2 N.N.C. § 401(B)(6)(a).
23	B. Pursuant to 15 N.N.C. § 1204 (B), the President of the Navajo Nation shall appoint the
24	five members of the board who represent the five agencies of the Navajo Nation, subject
25	to confirmation by the Naabik'íyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. See also
26	CJY-35-13.
. 27	
28	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS
29	A. Pursuant to 15 N.N.C. § 1204 (A), the Corporation shall be governed by a board of
30	regents composed of six members. There shall be one member of the board appointed

from each of the five agencies of the Navajo Nation. These five Board members shall have experience in the fields of education, business, science or technology or any other related field, and at a minimum, a bachelor's degree. The President of the Student Senate of the Navajo Technical University shall serve as a member of the Board by virtue of his/her office and shall be a voting member of the Board. *See also* CJY-35-12.

- B. Pursuant to 15 N.N.C. § 1204 (C), Board members shall serve terms of four years each, with the exception of the President of the Student Senate, who shall serve as a board member by virtue of his/her office. The terms shall be staggered. A Board member shall continue to serve after the formal expiration of the term until a successor has been confirmed by the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. The appointed Board members' terms of office shall begin upon their confirmation by the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. The Board shall notify the President of the Navajo Nation of an approaching vacancy and may recommend to the President of the Navajo Nation persons to fill vacancies on the board. A Board member may be re-appointed to subsequent terms of office. *Id.*
 - C. The Navajo Nation President Dr. Buu Nygren has appointed Mrs. Tara Denetsosie-Lovato to serve as a member of the Board of Regents to represent the Central Agency for a term of four years, letter of appointment attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

D. Mrs. Tara Denetsosie-Lovato meets the qualifications as required by 15 N.N.C § 1204
(A). See Letter of Interest, Résumé, and Certificate of Navajo Indian Blood attached hereto as Exhibits B, C and D, respectively.

SECTION THREE. CONFIRMING APPOINTMENT

The Navajo Nation hereby finds that Mrs. Tara Denetsosie-Lovato meets the qualifications set forth in 15 N.N.C. § 1204 (B) and confirms the appointment of Mrs. Tara Denetsosie-Lovato to serve on the Navajo Technical University Board of Regents as a representative of the Central Agency for a staggered term of four years, effective upon confirmation by the Naabik'íyáti' Committee, set forth in 15 N.N.C. § 1204 (C).
