19	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
20	A. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee is a standing committee of Navajo Nation Council. 2	
21	N.N.C. § 700 (A).	
22	B. All Navajo Nation public officials, elected and non-elected, who receive gifts,	
23	whether intended as a gift to the individual official or to the Navajo Nation, shall	
24	record or cause to be recorded such gift with the Ethics and Rules Office." 2 N.N.C.

26	C. The President of the Navajo Nation shall, for and on behalf of the Navajo Nation,	
27	accept or decline gifts of property, including monetary donations, provided that any	
28	such acceptance or refusal of a gift with an estimated value in excess of \$1,000 shall	
29	be with the concurrence of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 1010.

#### **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

- A. The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship and Financial Assistance ("ONNSFA") has received several monetary donations from several sources. The memo from ONNSFA acknowledging receipt of the donation, the acceptance memo from the Navajo Nation President, and the budget forms are included for each donation package.
- B. The documents for a donation of \$5000 from Barrow Hanley Mewhinney & Strauss, LLC, for \$5,000 are attached as **Exhibit A.**
- C. The documents for a donation of \$1880.46 from Teachers College Press are attached as **Exhibit B.**
- D. The documents for a donation of \$2,000.00 from Irene R. Spelling are attached as Exhibit C.
- E. The documents for a donation of \$1,250.00 from Elizabeth Prendergast are attached as Exhibit D.
- F. The Executive Official Review, attached as **Exhibit E**, reflects all reviewers have determined to be legally sufficient.

## SECTION THREE. CONCURRING WITH THE NAVAJO NATION PRESIDENT'S ACCEPTANCE OF DONATIONS TO ONNSFA

- A. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 1010, the Naabik'íyáti' Committee hereby gives its concurrence with the Navajo Nation President's acceptance of the various donations to the ONNSFA totaling \$10,130.46, as shown in **Exhibits A-D.**
- B. The donated funds shall be deposited into the appropriate business unit accounts as instructed by the Office of the Controller.
- C. All donated funds shall be used for the benefit of Navajo students pursuing their education and training goals, in accordance with the proposed budgets shown in Exhibits A-D.
- D. The ONNFSA shall record the receipt of all donated funds with the Navajo Nation Ethics and Rules Office, in accordance with 2 N.N.C. § 1012.

### SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Action shall become effective in accordance with 2 N.N.C. § 189(A).
