TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; RECOMMENDING THE REMOVAL OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN CONFIRMED BY THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

PURPOSE: This proposed resolution will recommend the removal of Navajo Nation division/department Executive Director who have not been confirmed by the Navajo Nation Council.

FINAL AUTHORITY: Navajo Nation Council

VOTING REQUIREMENT: Simple Majority

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

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18	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
19	A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation and shall	
20	confirm the appointments of all division directors upon recommendation from the	
21	appropriate oversight committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 102 (A) and (F).	
22	B. A proposed resolution requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be	
23	assigned to the Naabik'íyáti Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A) (9).	
24	C. The Navajo Department of Health is administered by an Executive Director and Deputy	
25	Director. The Executive Director shall be appointed by the President of the Navajo	
26	Nation, with the approval and recommendation of the Health, Education and Human	
27	Services Committee "and the consent of the Navajo Nation Council" and shall serve at	
28	the pleasure of the President of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 1605.	
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- D. The Executive Director of the Division of Human Resources shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the President of the Navajo Nation and confirmed by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 1703 (A).
- E. The Navajo Division of Economic Development is administered by an Executive Director, who shall be appointed by the President of the Navajo Nation, "with the consent of the Navajo Nation Council," and who shall serve at the pleasure of the President of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C § 1503.
- F. The President of the Navajo Nation shall employ an Executive Director of the Navajo Telecommunications Regulatory Commission who shall serve at the pleasure of the President of the Navajo Nation and be subject to confirmation by the Government Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C § 3455.
- G. The Navajo Division of Community Development shall be administered by a Division Director, who shall be appointed by the President of the Navajo Nation, confirmed by the Navajo Nation Council, and who shall serve at the pleasure of the President of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C § 1453(A).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. Since July 2023, Ms. Sherylene Yazzie has been serving as the Executive Director of the Department of Health.
- B. Since July 2024, Ms. Reycita Toddy has been serving as the Executive Director of the Division of Human Resources.
- C. Since January 2023, Mr. Tony Skrelunas has been serving as the Executive Director of the Division of Economic Development.
- D. Since July 2024, Mr. Bryon C. Shorty has been serving as the Executive Director of the Telecommunications Regulatory Commission.
- E. Since January 2025, Ms. Candice Yazzie has been serving as the Executive Director of the Division of Community Development.
- F. The above-mentioned Executive Directors, whether through interim or permanent appointment, have been serving in such capacity in excess of three (3) months without confirmation by the Navajo Nation Council.

- G. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C § 102(F), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council shall confirm the appointments of all division directors upon recommendation from the appropriate oversight committee. The President shall present the appointments at the next Navajo Nation Council session following the date the appointments are made."
- H. The President of the Navajo Nation shall "[f]aithfully execute and enforce the laws of the Navajo Nation." 2 N.N.C § 1005 (F)(1).

SECTION THREE. RECOMMENDATION OF REMOVAL

- A. The Navajo Nation Council hereby expresses its dissatisfaction with the delay to have the Executive Directors of the Navajo Department of Health, Division of Human Resources, Division of Economic Development, Telecommunications Regulatory Commission, and Division of Community Development confirmed by the Navajo Nation Council as required under Navajo law.
- B. The Navajo Nation Council hereby recommends to the Navajo Nation President Dr. Buu Nygren, to remove Ms. Sherylene Yazzie, Ms. Reycita Toddy, Mr. Tony Skrelunas, Mr. Bryon C. Shorty, and Ms. Candice Yazzie from their respective Executive Director positions if there is no resolution confirming their respective appointments by the adjournment of the Navajo Nation Council 2025 Summer Session.
