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17	SECTION 1. AUTHORITY	
18	A. The Resources and Development Committee has oversight authority over the Navajo	
19	Division of Transportation. 2 N.N.C. § 501(C)(1).	
20	B. It is the purpose of the Health, Education and Human Services Committee "[t]o oversee	
21	Navajo Nation efforts in implementing and ensuring compliance with employment and	
22	labor laws and policies of the Navajo Nation" 2 N.N.C. § 400(C)(3).	
23	C. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee has the power to establish	
24	Navajo Nation policy, promulgate rules and regulations governing human services	
25	and general government serves of the Navajo Nation" 2 N.N.C. § 401(B)(1).	
26	D. "To the extent the programs are required to develop policies that supplement [the	
27	Personnel Polices Manual], they shall be reviewed by the Department of Justice and	
28	approved by the Health, Education and Human Services Committee prior to	
29	implementation by the program." Personnel Polices Manual, I (C)(2).	
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SECTION 2. FINDINGS

- A. The Division of Transportation has requested approval of the Navajo Division of Transportation Social Media Policy which is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- B. The Division of Transportation Division Director, in memorandum attached as **Exhibit B**, states that "[t]his policy is established for all full-time, part-time, and temporary
 Navajo DOT employees to promote and encourage responsible and professional use of
 social media to the highest standards of professional conduct, including the
 dissemination of accurate, reliable, objective, and inclusive information that reflects the
 diversity of the Navajo DOT culture and society."
- C. The Executive Official Review Number 024444 is attached as **Exhibit C**. The Department of Justice has determined the document Legally Sufficient."

SECTION 3. APPROVING THE NAVAJO DIVISION OF TRANSPORTATION SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY
