

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §500 (A).
- B. The Resources and Development Committee is authorized to grant final approval for the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (“NAHASDA”) Indian Housing Plan. 2 N.N.C. §501 (B)(2)(b).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Navajo Housing Authority has prepared the Fiscal Year 2026 Navajo Nation Housing Plan for the NAHASDA Indian Housing Block Grant which is attached as Exhibit A.

1 B. The Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority, by Resolution NHA-
2 5289-2025, attached as **Exhibit B**, requests the support and endorsement of the
3 Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council and
4 request authorization to submit Navajo Nation's FY 2026 Indian Housing Plan to
5 the United State Department of Housing and Urban Development on behalf of the
6 Navajo Nation.

8 **SECTION THREE. APPROVAL**

9 A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby
10 approves the Fiscal Year 2026 Navajo Nation Housing Plan for the NAHASDA
11 Indian Housing Block Grant funding, as provided in **Exhibit A**.

12 B. The Resources and Development Committee approves the Navajo Housing
13 Authority's Navajo Nation Indian Housing Plan on behalf of the Navajo Nation.

14 C. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby
15 authorizes the President of the Navajo Nation to execute any and all documents to
16 affect the intent and purpose of this resolution.
