

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITIES

Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 500 (B) (2), the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has the authority to grant final approval for all land withdrawals, non-mineral leases, permits, licenses, right-of-way, surface easements and bonding requirements on Navajo Nation lands and unrestricted (fee) land. This authority shall include subleases, modifications, assignments, leasehold encumbrances, transfers, renewals, and terminations.

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

1 A. The Resources and Development Committee by resolution RDCMY-11-25 approved  
2 a right-of-way to the New Mexico Department of Transportation for NMDOT US 64  
3 CN 5100821, Milepost 20.6 to 22. RDCMY-11-25 (without exhibits) is attached as  
4 **Exhibit A.**

5 B. The New Mexico Department of Transportation requests an amendment to RDCMY-  
6 11-25 to approve a waiver of valuation pursuant to 25 CFR § 169.110.

7 C. 25 CFR § 169.110 addresses waiver of valuation for a right-of-way over or across  
8 tribal land. It states:

9 *(a) A right-of-way over or across tribal land may allow for any payment amount*  
10 *negotiated by the tribe, and we will defer to the tribe and not require a valuation if*  
11 *the tribe submits a tribal authorization expressly stating that it:*

12 *(1) Has agreed upon compensation satisfactory to the tribe;*

13 *(2) Waives valuation; and*

14 *(3) Has determined that accepting such agreed-upon compensation and waiving*  
15 *valuation is in its best interest.*

16 *(b) The tribe may request, in writing, that we determine fair market value, in which*  
17 *case we will use a valuation in accordance with § 169.114. After providing the tribe*  
18 *with the fair market value, we will defer to a tribe's decision to allow for any*  
19 *compensation negotiated by the tribe.*

20 *(c) If the conditions in paragraph (a) or (b) of this section are not met, we will require*  
21 *that the grantee pay fair market value based on a valuation in accordance with §*  
22 *169.114.*

24 **SECTION THREE. APPROVING WAIVER OF VALUATION OF THE RIGHT-**  
25 **OF-WAY**

26 A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby  
27 approves an amendment to RDCMY-11-25 by waiving the valuation of the right-of-  
28 way to New Mexico Department of Transportation because the agreed upon  
29 compensation is satisfactory and it has determined that accepting such agreed-upon  
30 compensation and waiving valuation is in the Nation's best interest.
