TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE AND BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE; AMENDING CRYSTAL CHAPTER PROJECTS INCLUDED IN COUNCIL DELEGATE ANDY NEZ'S DELEGATE REGION PROJECT PLAN CURRENTLY FUNDED THROUGH THE REVENUE REPLACEMENT RESERVE

**PURPOSE:** This proposed resolution will amend Crystal Chapter Projects including Honorable Andy Nez's Delegate Region Project Plan.

19	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
20	A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo	
. 21	Nation Council with the delegated authority to review, coordinate and approve projects	
22	on the Navajo Nation to be financed by funds designated for capital improvement. 2	
23	N.N.C. § 500 (C)(5).	
24	B. The Budget and Finance Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation	
25	Council with the delegated responsibility to protect the interests of the Navajo People	
26	through the prudent management of financial reserves of the Navajo Nation and the use	
27	of funds available for expenditure by the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 300 (C)(4).	
28	C. Delegate Region Project Plans funded through the General Fund Revenue Replacement	
29	Reserve shall only be amended by resolution of the Budget and Finance Committee	
30	when recommended by the Resource and Development Committee. CMY-28-24, § (F).	
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## **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

- A. Council Resolution CMY-28-24, incorporated by reference, established the Revenue Replacement Reserve as a committed fund balance within the Navajo Nation General Fund for the purpose of housing, protecting, and reserving certain funds from the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund ("NNFRF") until the Navajo Nation established a statutory trust fund that will be used to leverage funding for government services and long-term infrastructure development. CMY-28-24, § 5.
- B. The following provisions of CMY-28-24 specifically apply to Delegate Region Project Plans funded through the Revenue Replacement Reserve:
  - 1. To provide more flexibility and increase the time available to complete Delegate Region Project Plans, the Navajo Nation reallocated *unobligated* and unspent Delegate Region Project Plan funds from the NNFRF to the Revenue Replacement Reserve. Delegate Region Project Plans funded through the Revenue Replacement Reserve are not subject to U.S. Treasury rules and guidance. CMY-28-24, § 6(A).
  - 2. The transfer of Delegate Region Project Plan funding from the NNFRF to the Revenue Replacement Reserve shall not increase or decrease the eight million eight hundred two thousand three hundred forty dollars (\$8,802,340) dollars allocated to each Delegate Region pursuant to Resolution CJN-29-22, § 3. CMY-28-24, § 6(C).
  - 3. The Office of the Controller, with the assistance of the NNFRF Office and Office of Management and Budget, shall administratively implement the transfer of unobligated and unspent Delegate Region Project Plans from the NNFRF to the Revenue Replacement Reserve. The transfer shall keep the Delegate Region Project Plans intact. CMY-28-24, § 6(D).
  - 4. Delegate Region Project Plans funded through the Revenue Replacement Reserve shall be limited to the following purposes, unless otherwise excepted through resolution of the Navajo Nation Council: Projects for programs to provide government services to Chapter members; to provide basic PPE to Chapter members; to provide food, fuel, firewood assistance

to Chapter members; for construction projects such as renovations to Chapter houses, new housing construction, housing renovations, and house wiring; to plan and design projects; to hire consultants to assist with eligible programs and projects; to hire PEP workers, student workers and other temporary employees, or regular status employees to assist the Chapter governments in carrying out eligible programs and projects. Delegate Region Project Plans shall not include vaccinations or any cash assistance for Chapter members, such as a hardship assistance program. CMY-28-24, § 6(E).

- 5. Delegate Region Project Plans funded through the General Fund Revenue Replacement Reserve shall only be amended by resolution of the Budget and Finance Committee when recommended by the Resource and Development Committee. CMY-28-24, § 6(F).
- C. Crystal Chapter has requested that the Delegate Region Project Plan covering the Crystal Chapter be amended as set forth in the April 3, 2025, memorandum, attached as **Exhibit A.**
- D. Crystal Chapter provided the following expenditure plan:
  - 1. NO1687 (Rural Addressing) reduced by \$100,000 as set forth in Exhibit B;
  - 2. NO1693 (Grader) increased by \$48,000 as set forth in Exhibit C;
  - 3. NO1692 (4x4 Truck) increased by \$20,000 as set forth in Exhibit D; and
  - 4. NO1694 (Multi-Purpose Building Maintenance) increased by \$32,000 as set forth in Exhibit E.
- E. Crystal Chapter is included in Council Delegate Andy Nez's Delegate Region.
- F. As required by CMY-28-24, the Resources and Development Committee recommends that the Delegate Region Project Plan for Delegate Andy Nez's Delegate Region be amended as provided in **Exhibits B, C, D, and E.**

SECTION THREE. APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO CRYSTAL CHAPTER PROJECTS INCLUDED IN DELEGATE ANDY NEZ'S DELEGATE REGION PROJECT PLANS

- A. The Navajo Nation, through the Resources and Development and Budget and Finance Committees, approves the changes to the Crystal Chapter projects previously approved by CAP-19-23 as set forth in **Exhibits A-E.**
- B. The changes to the Crystal Chapter project set forth above are in compliance with CMY-28-24 and do not increase the overall costs of Delegate Andy Nez's Delegate Region Project Plan.

## SECTION FOUR. SAVING CLAUSE

Should any provision of this legislation or the Capital Development and Financing Act be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or a District Court of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those portions of the legislation or Act which are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.
