24	whether intended as a gift to the individual official or to the Navajo Nation, shall
25	record or cause to be recorded such gift with the Ethics and Rules Office. 2 N.N.C. §

27	C. The President of the Navajo Nation shall, for and on behalf of the Navajo Nation,
28	accept or decline gifts of property, including monetary donations, provided that any
29	such acceptance or refusal of a gift with an estimated value in excess of \$1,000 shall
30	be with the concurrence of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 1010.

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS 1 A. The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship and Financial Assistance ("ONNSFA") has 2 3 received a monetary donation from the Edna Bailey Sussman Fund. B. The documents required to accept the donation of \$300,000 from the Edna Bailey 4 5 Sussman Fund are attached as Exhibit A. C. The Executive Official Review, attached as **Exhibit B**, reflects all reviewers have 6 7 determined to be legally sufficient. 8 SECTION THREE. CONCURRING WITH THE NAVAJO NATION PRESIDENT'S 9 ACCEPTANCE OF DONATIONS TO OFFICE OF NAVAJO 10 SCHOLARSHIP AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE 11 A. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 1010, the Naabik'íyáti' Committee hereby concurs for the 12 Navajo Nation President's acceptance of the various donations to the ONNSFA 13 totaling \$300,000.00, as shown in Exhibit A. 14 B. The donated funds shall be deposited into the appropriate business unit account as 15 instructed by the Office of the Controller. 16 C. The donated fund shall be used for the benefit of Navajo students pursuing their 17 education and training goals, in accordance with the proposed budget shown in 18 Exhibit A. 19 D. The ONNFSA shall record the receipt of all donated funds with the Navajo Nation 20 Ethics and Rules Office, in accordance with 2 N.N.C. § 1012. 21 22 SECTION FOUR.
