30	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	

- A. The Executive Director of the Department of Health shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the President of the Navajo Nation and confirmed by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §1605.
- B. The establishment of the Department of Health and the duties of the Executive Director are outlined at 2 N.N.C. § 1601 et seq.
- C. The Navajo Nation President appointed Sherylene Yazzie as the Executive Director of the Navajo Department of Health. The appointment letter and résumé are attached as **Exhibits A** and **B**, respectively.

SECTION THREE. APPROVING THE CONFIRMATION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

The Navajo Nation Council hereby confirms the appointment of Sherylene Yazzie as the Executive Director of the Navajo Department of Health.
