PURPOSE: The purpose of this proposed resolution is to confirm the reappointment of Mr. Earl Tulley to the Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission as the Chinle Agency Commissioner.

COMMISSIONER PURSUANT TO NAVAJO NATION WATER RIGHTS
COMMISSION PLAN OF OPERATION

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C §500(A).
- B. The Resources and Development Committee has final authority to confirm appointments of members to the Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission (“NNWRC”). 2 N.N.C. §501(B)(9) and Resolution GSCAP-07-04, NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 5(B).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The purpose of the Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission is to ensure that the water rights of the Navajo Nation are vigorously pursued, effectively coordinated,

1 and to enhance the communication between all entities engaged in water rights efforts
2 on behalf of the Navajo Nation. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 2.

3 B. The Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission shall consist of seven (7) members
4 with no less than five (5) members being enrolled members of the Navajo Nation.
5 NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 4(A).

6 C. No elected official from any city, county, state, federal or tribal government shall be
7 eligible for appointment to the NNWRC. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 4(F).

8 D. Commission members representing the Navajo public shall serve a term of four (4)
9 years and may be reappointed. Terms will expire on November 19 of the appropriate
10 year. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 4(C).

11 E. The Speaker of the Navajo Nation shall appoint two (2) members; the President of
12 the Navajo Nation shall appoint two (2) members; and the Chief Justice of the Navajo
13 Nation shall appoint one (1) member. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 5(A).

14 F. The Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council is assigned to appoint one (1) member
15 from the Eastern Agency and one (1) member from the Fort Defiance Agency; the
16 President of the Navajo Nation is assigned to appoint one (1) member from the
17 Shiprock Agency and one(1) member from the Chinle Agency; and the Chief Justice
18 of the Navajo Nation is assigned to appoint one (1) member from the Western
19 Agency. Such recommendations may be of individuals with experience in, but not
20 limited to the fields of engineering, economics, hydrology, natural resources law or
21 serving in the capacity as a public official. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 5(C).

22 G. In 2021, the President of the Navajo Nation Jonathan Nez appointed Mr. Earl Tulley
23 to the NNWRC Chinle Agency Commissioner and Mr. Earl Tulley was confirmed as
24 the NNWRC Chinle Agency Commissioner by the Resources and Development
25 Committee in RDCAU-21-21.

26 H. Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission Commissioners may be reappointed to
27 another four-year term according to the NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 4(C).

28 I. Mr. Earl Tulley fulfills the requirements for reappointment as the Chinle Agency
29 Commissioner of the NNWRC. Mr. Tulley's Birth Certificate that lists his Certificate
30

1 of Navajo Indian Blood number as his middle name, letter of interest for
2 reappointment to the NNWRC, and his resume are attached as **Exhibit A**.

- 3 J. The President of the Navajo Nation has reappointed Mr. Earl Tulley as the Chinle
4 Agency Commissioner of the NNWRC. Navajo Nation President Dr. Buu Nygren's
5 NNWRC reappointment letter for Mr. Earl Tulley is attached as **Exhibit B**.

7 **SECTION THREE. APPOINTMENT**

8 The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby
9 Confirms President Dr. Buu Nygren's reappointment of Mr. Earl Tulley to the Navajo
10 Nation Water Rights Commission for a four-year term as the Chinle Agency
11 Commissioner which shall expire on November 19, 2027, in accordance with the
12 NNWRC Plan of Operation.
