19	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
20	A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo	
21	Nation Council. 2 N.N.C §500(A).	
22	B. The Resources and Development Committee has final authority to confirm	
23	appointments of members to the Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission	
. 24	("NNWRC"). 2 N.N.C. §501(B)(9) and Resolution GSCAP-07-04, NNWRC Plan of	
25	Operation, Article 5(B).

27	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
28	A. The purpose of the Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission is to ensure that the	
29	water rights of the Navajo Nation are vigorously pursued, effectively coordinated,

- and to enhance the communication between all entities engaged in water rights efforts on behalf of the Navajo Nation. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 2.
- B. The Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission shall consist of seven (7) members with no less than five (5) members being enrolled members of the Navajo Nation. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 4(A).
- C. No elected official from any city, county, state, federal or tribal government shall be eligible for appointment to the NNWRC. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 4(F).
- D. Commission members representing the Navajo public shall serve a term of four (4) years and may be reappointed. Terms will expire on November 19 of the appropriate year. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 4(C).
- E. The Speaker of the Navajo Nation shall appoint two (2) members; the President of the Navajo Nation shall appoint two (2) members; and the Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation shall appoint one (1) member. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 5(A).
- F. The Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council is assigned to appoint one (1) member from the Eastern Agency and one (1) member from the Fort Defiance Agency; the President of the Navajo Nation is assigned to appoint one (1) member from the Shiprock Agency and one (1) member from the Chinle Agency; and the Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation is assigned to appoint one (1) member from the Western Agency. Such recommendations may be of individuals with experience in, but not limited to the fields of engineering, economics, hydrology, natural resources law or serving in the capacity as a public official. NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 5(C).
- G. In 2020, Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation Joanne Jayne appointed Ms. Joelynn Ashley as the NNWRC Western Agency Commissioner and Ms. Joelynn Ashley was confirmed as the NNWRC Western Agency Commissioner by the Resources and Development Committee in RDCO-40-20.
- H. Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission Commissioners may be reappointed to another four-year term according to the NNWRC Plan of Operation, Article 4(C).
- I. Ms. Joelynn Ashley fulfills the requirements to be reappointed as the Western Agency Commissioner of the NNWRC. Ms. Ashley's Certificate of Navajo Indian Blood,

letter of interest to be reappointed to the NNWRC, and her resume are attached as **Exhibit A**.

J. The Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation has reappointed Ms. Joelynn Ashley as the Western Agency Commissioner of the NNWRC. Chief Justice Joanne Jayne's NNWRC reappointment letter for Ms. Ashley to the Resource and Development Chair is attached as Exhibit B.

SECTION THREE. APPOINTMENT

The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby confirms Chief Justice Joanne Jayne's reappointment of Ms. Joelynn Ashley to the Navajo Nation Water Rights Commission for a four-year term as the Western Agency Commissioner which shall expire on November 19, 2026, in accordance with the NNWRC Plan of Operation.
