TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; EXTENDING THE TIME FOR A LIMITED WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2029 TO ALLOW THE NAVAJO NATION TO BE SUED IN FEDERAL DISTRICT COURT REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT IN CARRYING OUT UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANTS AND AUTHORIZING THE NAVAJO NATION PRESIDENT TO BE THE CERTIFYING TRIBAL OFFICIAL TO EXECUTE FORM 7015.15

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize an extension of time for a limited waiver of sovereign immunity to allow the Navajo Nation to be sued in the Federal District Court for compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (or "NEPA") to carry out the federal Housing and Urban Development grants and to authorize the Navajo Nation President to sign form 7015.15 "Request for Release of Fund and Certification".

FINAL AUTHORITY: Navajo Nation Council

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

24	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
25	A. The Resources and Development Committee was established as a standing committee	
26	of the Navajo Nation Council with oversight over housing for the purposes of	
27	establishing policies and legislation appropriate to the housing needs of the Navajo	
28	Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 500(C)(3).	
29	B. The Navajo Nation established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation	
30	Council standing committee. Any proposed legislation requiring Navajo Nation	

- Council approval shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee to. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(9).
- C. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 102(A).

## **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

- A. Resolution CJA-13-00 approved a limited waiver of sovereign immunity allowing the Navajo Nation to be sued in Federal District Court regarding compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (or "NEPA") in carrying out United States Housing and Urban Development (or "HUD") grants and further authorizing the Navajo Nation President to sign Form 7015.15 as the certified tribal official for HUD-funded projects through Fiscal Year 2004.
- B. There have been five similar resolutions of the Navajo Nation Council related to HUD grant funding granting the continued extension of a limited waiver of sovereign immunity and authorizing the Navajo Nation President to sign Form 7015.15. See CAP-21-05; CAP-15-10; CJA-03-14; CO-57-17; and CJY-39-22.
- C. Pursuant to CJY-39-22, the current limited waiver of sovereign immunity expires on September 30, 2025.
- D. The Board of Commissioners of the Navajo Housing Authority approved Resolution NHA-5258-2024, attached as **Exhibit 1**, supporting an extension of the limited waiver of sovereign immunity through September 30, 2029 and the authorization of the Navajo Nation President to sign Form 7015.

## SECTION THREE. APPROVAL & AUTHORIZATION

The Navajo Nation hereby approves and authorizes the extension of a limited waiver of sovereign immunity through September 30, 2029 to allow the Navajo Nation to be sued in Federal District Court regarding compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act in carrying out Housing and Urban Development grants and authorizes the Navajo Nation President to sign Form 7015.15.
