20	B. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council
21	with the enumerated authority and responsibility to serve as the oversight committee
22	for commissions established under the Legislative Branch, such as the Navajo-Hopi
23	Land Commission. 2 N.N.C. § 701 (A)(5).

25	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS
26	A. As the legislative oversight authority for the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission Office,
. 27	the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission has authority to recommend amendments to the
28	Office's Plan of Operation.
29	B. The Navajo-Hopi Land Commission Office desires its Plan of Operation to reflect
30	changes in settlements and the amendment of tribal and federal laws.
