18	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
19	A. The Naabik'íyáti Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council has	
. 20	the authority to grant final confirmation of appointments to boards, commissions, and	
21	colleges unless otherwise provided in law. 2 N.N.C. § 701 (A) (1).	
22	B. An appointment to the Black Mesa Review Board as made by the respective Chapter	
23	requires confirmation by the [Naabik'íyáti] Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 903(B).

· 25	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
26	A. The purpose of the Black Mesa Review Board (the "Board") shall be to advocate for fair	
27	and just compensation for Navajo families within the five Navajo Nation Chapters whose	
28	socio-economic and environmental interests are adversely affected or impacted by coal	
29	mining and related operations of Peabody Western Coal Company ("PWCC"). The Board	
. 30	may also make appropriate recommendations to the President of the Navajo Nation, the

Navajo Nation Council, the Resources Committee of the Navajo Nation Council, or to PWCC, concerning the health, social welfare, education, and environment of the Navajo People affected by any of PWCC's mining and post-mining or related operations. 2 N.N.C. § 902.

- B. The Black Mesa Review Board shall be comprised of seven (7) members, one of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council. Each Board appointee shall serve a term of four (4) years. 2 N.N.C. § 903.
- C. The Kayenta Chapter has appointed Phillip Etsitty to the Black Mesa Review Board by Resolution KY25-05-019, which is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- D. Within thirty (30) days of their appointment, each Board appointee shall be presented to the Naabik'íyáti Committee of the Navajo Nation Council for confirmation. 2 N.N.C. § 903 (B).
- E. If confirmed by the Naabik'íyáti Committee, Mr. Etsitty's term shall not commence until he is administered an oath of office by a judge or justice of the Navajo Nation courts. 2 N.N.C. § 903 (B).

SECTION THREE. CONFIRMATION

The Naabik'íyáti Committee of the Navajo Nation Council confirms the appointment of Phillip Etsitty as the Kayenta Chapter representative to the Black Mesa Review Board for a term of four (4) years.
