18	A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation and shall	
19	confirm the appointments of all division directors upon recommendation	on from the

22	B. A proposed resolution requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Coun	cil shall be
23	assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9).	
24	C. The Law and Order Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nati	ion Council
25	with oversight authority over the Navajo Nation Department of Justi	ce and the

28	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS.	
29	A. "The Attorney General is the Chief Legal Officer of the Navajo Nation	and, unless
30	otherwise provided by Navajo Nation law, shall have charge of the Dep	partment of

- Justice and of all legal matters in which the Navajo Nation government has an interest." 2 N.N.C. § 1964 (A).
- B. The Attorney General shall "render legal services to the Navajo Nation government, including its Chapters, branches, and entities, subject to available resources, as may be required". 2 N.N.C. § 1964 (B).
- C. The Navajo Nation Council appoints the Navajo Nation Attorney General at the recommendation of the Navajo Nation President. 2 N.N.C. § 1962 (B).
- D. The Navajo Nation President recommends Colin Bradley, Esq., as the Navajo Nation Attorney General. Mr. Bradley's appointment letter is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- E. Colin Bradley is qualified to be the Attorney General and is a member of the Navajo Nation. Mr. Bradley's Resume and Certificate of Indian Blood for the Navajo Nation is attached as **Exhibit B**.
- F. The Navajo Nation Attorney General serves at the pleasure of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 1962 (B).

SECTION THREE. APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION

- A. The Navajo Nation Council appoints and confirms Colin Bradley, Esq., as the Navajo Nation Attorney General.
- B. Mr. Bradley shall serve at the pleasure of the Navajo Nation Council and his term shall run concurrent with the term of the Navajo Nation President.
