17	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY		
18	A. The Budget and Finance Committee shall make recommendations concerning the budget and		
19	submit it to the Navajo Nation Council for deliberation and approval. 12 N.N.C. § 840(A).		
20	B. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee is assigned proposed resolutions that require final action by		
21	the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §164 (A)(9).		
22	C. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 102(A).

24	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS		
25	A. The Navajo Nation Council approved CS-44-25, the Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2026		
26	Comprehensive Budget, on September 4, 2025, the resolution was certified and submitted		
27	to the Office of the President and Vice-President on September 10, 2025, and the Navajo		
28	Nation President line-item vetoed and signed CS-44-25 on September 15, 2025.		
29	B. The President line-item vetoed a total of \$22,833,129 which is now considered		
30	unappropriated projected funds. The Navajo Nation hereby amends the Fiscal Year 2026

Comprehensive Budget as indicated in the paragraphs below and summarized in attached Exhibit A.

- C. As a result of the Navajo Nation President's exercise of the line-item veto authority in Council Resolution CS-44-25, legislative branch offices and programs have been impacted severely that they are unable to continue operations in Fiscal Year 2026.
- D. The 25<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council and the President, have emphasized the importance of restoring funding to the Legislative and Judicial Branches to ensure continuity in its operation, as indicated in attached Exhibits B and C.
- E. The Navajo Nation Council amends the Fiscal Year 2026 Comprehensive Budget as indicated in Section Three, below.

## SECTION THREE. AMENDING CS-44-25, THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL YEAR **2026 BUDGET**

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the appropriations for Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2026 as listed here for the Legislative Branch for the following items, totaling \$8,100,263, from the General Funds. Upon approval, each Program will submit complete budget packets, including authorized signatures, to the Office of the Controller and the Office of Management and Budget based on the appropriations, as indicated in Exhibit D and as follows:
  - 1. Navajo Nation Council, BU# 101001, in the amount of \$2,041,003.
  - 2. Budget and Finance Committee, BU# 101003, in the amount of \$60,374.
  - 3. Office of the Speaker, BU# 101015, in the amount of \$478,337.

- 11. Navajo Youth Advisory Council BU# 101XXX, in the amount of \$245,043.
- 12. Legislative Personnel Adjustment Pool BU# 102021, managed by Department of Personnel Management, in the amount of 1,012,970.
- B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the appropriations for Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2026 as listed here for the Judicial Branch for the following items, totaling \$941,732, from the General Funds. Upon approval, each Program will submit complete budget packets, including authorized signatures, to the Office of the Controller and the Office of Management and Budget based on the appropriations, as indicated in **Exhibit E** and as follows:
  - 1. Admin. Office of the Courts, BU# 102001, in the amount of \$171,288.
  - 2. Chinle Judicial District, BU# 102002, in the amount of \$86,401.

## SECTION FOUR. DIRECTIVE TO THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET

- A. The Navajo Nation Council directs the Office of Management and Budget to immediately recalculate the final monetary totals such that the figures conform to the amendments passed by the Navajo Nation Council.
- B. The Navajo Nation Council directs the Office of Management and Budget to make any other changes to the exhibits such that they conform to the amendments passed by the Navajo Nation Council.

### SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE

The Navajo Nation Amended Fiscal Year 2026 Comprehensive Budget enacted herein shall be effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §§ 164(A)(17) and 221(B).
