19	A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo	
20	Nation Council with oversight authority over the Navajo Nation Division of	
21	Community Development. 2 N.N.C. §§ 500(A) and 501 (C)(1).	
22	B. The Resources and Development Committee has the power to represent the Navajo	
23	Nation at local, state, and federal levels, in cooperation and coordination with the	
24	President of the Navajo Nation and the appropriate Committee of the Navajo Nation	
25	Council on proposed resolutions or actions affecting housing development. 2

28	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
29	A. The Indian Community Development Block Grant ("ICDBG") program provides	
30	eligible grantees with direct grants for use in developing viable Indian and Alaska	

- Native Communities, including decent housing, a suitable living environment, and economic opportunities, primarily for low- and moderate-income persons.
- B. The Navajo Nation Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program is established under the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development with the role to administer the CDBG program consistent with guidelines, interpret rules governing the CDBG program, provide technical assistance on proposal writing, apply for ICDBG grants, and to keep the Nation abreast of latest developments at the national level.
- C. Prior to the submission of the Fiscal Year 25 ("FY25") ICDBG application, the Navajo Nation must certify through a tribal resolution that the Navajo Nation has met the Citizen Participation requirements set forth in the Code of Federal Regulations ("CFR") at 24 CFR 1003.604, which is attached as Exhibit A.
- D. The relevant CFR provision on citizen participation requires the applicant, in this instance the Navajo Nation, to follow traditional means of resident involvement to include, at a minimum:
 - 1. Furnishing residents with information concerning the amounts of funds available for proposed community development and housing activities and the range of activities that may be undertaken,
 - 2. Holding on or more meetings to obtain the views of residents on community development and housing needs. Meetings shall be scheduled in ways and at times that will allow participation by residents.
 - 3. Developing and publishing or posting a community development statement in such a manner as to afford affected residents an opportunity to examine its contents and to submit comments.
 - 4. Affording residents an opportunity to review and comment on the applicant's performance under any active community block grant.
- E. The ICDBG Citizen Participation Plan and FY25 public hearing documents submitted to satisfy the CFR's requirements include:
 - 1. The Navajo Nation Community Development Block Grant Program, Citizen Participation Plan, attached as **Exhibit B**;
