16 **WHEREAS:**

18 A. The Navajo Nation established the Naabik'iyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation  
19 Council standing committee and as such empowered Naabik'iyáti Committee to assist  
20 and coordinate all requests for information, appearances and testimony relating to  
21 proposed county, state and federal legislation impacting the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C.  
22 §§ 700 (A) and 701 (A) (6).

23  
24 B. Each of the 25<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council Delegates representing New Mexico chapters  
25 and communities recommended New Mexico Legislative Priorities for 2026 for their  
26 respective area(s) of oversight to the New Mexico Caucus of the Navajo Nation  
27 Council; after review and discussion, the New Mexico Caucus compiled the  
28 recommendations into the 2026 New Mexico Legislative Priorities attached and  
29 incorporated herein as **Exhibit A**.

1       **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

2       The Navajo Nation hereby approves the Navajo Nation 2026 State of New Mexico  
3       legislative priorities, attached as **Exhibit A**, and authorizes the Navajo Nation President,  
4       the Navajo Nation Speaker, their designees, and the Naabik'iyáti' Committee Members,  
5       to advocate the position of the Navajo Nation with the State of New Mexico, the State of  
6       New Mexico Legislature, New Mexico State Agencies, and the State of New Mexico  
7       Governor's Office for preservation of funding and policies in the Navajo Nation's priority  
8       areas.
