PURPOSE: This resolution, if approved, would allocate \$84,000,000 from the Síhasin Fund to execute the Transportation Improvement Expenditure Plan for the Navajo Nation.



COUNCIL; ALLOCATING \$84,000,000 FROM THE NAVAJO NATION
SÍHASIN FUND FOR THE NAVAJO NATION TRANSPORTATION
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE NAVAJO
NATION TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT EXPENDITURE
PLAN PURSUANT TO 12 N.N.C §§ 2501 – 2508**

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Resources and Development Committee is empowered to exercise oversight of matters involving roads and transportation to oversee planning and coordination of roads and transportation activities. 2 N.N.C. §500(C)(6).
- B. The Budget and Finance Committee is empowered to “appropriate, allocate, cancel, re-appropriate and review the use of Navajo Nation funds received including but not limited to all grants, contracts, gifts and other funds from all sources.” 2 N.N.C. § 301(B)(3).

1 C. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council
2 empowered to hear proposed resolutions that require final action by the Navajo Nation
3 Council. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(9).

4 D. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §
5 102(A).

6 E. The Navajo Nation Code (at 12 N.N.C. § 2502, as amended by CJA-03-18) provides
7 that the purpose of the Navajo Nation Síhasin Fund (the "Síhasin Fund") is as follows:

8 **§ 2502 Purpose**

9 A. The purposes of this Fund are to provide financial support and/or financing
10 for:

- 11 1. The planning and development of economic development and regional
12 infrastructure supporting economic development and community
13 development, including such infrastructure as, but not limited to,
14 housing, commercial and government buildings, waterline, solid waste
15 management development, powerline projects, transportation and
16 communication systems, within the Navajo Nation; and

17 2. Education opportunities for members of the Navajo Nation.

18 B. For the Purpose in § 2502(A)(1), Fund expenditures for infrastructure shall
19 not be limited by 12 NNC § 1310(F) or TCDCJY-77-99.

20 C. Leveraging the Fund by way of guaranteeing loans, match funding, direct
21 funding in part, and other weighted uses of the Fund, including loan
22 financing from the Fund, for the purposes in § 2502(A)(1), shall be favored
23 over direct funding in whole.

24 F. The Síhasin Fund provides that "Fund Principal" shall consist of all deposits made to
25 the Síhasin Fund and that "Fund Income" shall consist of all earnings (interest,
26 dividends, etc.) generated and realized by the Fund Principal, and that Fund Income
27 shall be deposited in and added to Fund Principal until such time as a Fund Expenditure
28 Plan is duly adopted. 12 N.N.C. §§ 2504 and 2505 (C).

29 G. The Síhasin Fund provides that "Fund Principal and Income shall not be expended
30 except pursuant to a Fund Expenditure Plan consistent with the purposes set forth in §

1 2502 of this Chapter and adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members of the
2 Navajo Nation Council.” 12 N.N.C. § 2505(A).

4 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

- 5 A. Roads, bridges, and related transportation projects and facilities throughout the Navajo
6 Nation are in need of repair, rehabilitation and improvement to ensure safe passage
7 throughout the Navajo Nation.
- 8 B. The Navajo Division of Transportation (“Navajo DOT”) prepared the Navajo Nation
9 Transportation Improvement Expenditure Plan (“Transportation Improvement
10 Expenditure Plan”), which is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- 11 C. The Transportation Improvement Expenditure Plan includes 64 projects that distribute
12 funding in the amount of \$3,500,000 to each delegate region, for a total of \$84,000,000.
13 The projects include funding for project planning and design, road construction
14 shortfalls, and equipment acquisition.
- 15 D. In creating a plan that equally distributed funds for each delegate region, the Navajo
16 DOT made every effort to account for multiple variables to provide the most equitable
17 distribution possible.

18
19 **SECTION THREE. APPROVAL OF SÍHASIN FUNDING AND ADOPTION OF THE**
20 **TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT EXPENDITURE PLAN**

- 21 A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves and adopts funding for the Transportation
22 Improvement Expenditure Plan in the amount of \$84,000,000 from the Navajo Nation
23 Síhasin Fund, in accordance with 12 N.N.C. § 2505(A).
- 24 B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves and adopts the Transportation Improvement
25 Expenditure Plan, detailed in **Exhibit A**.
- 26 C. The Síhasin Funds allocated for the Road Improvement Expenditure Plan may be
27 further leveraged by bond or loan financing pursuant to the Navajo Nation Bond
28 Financing Act, 12 N.N.C. § 1300 *et seq.*, as amended, using Síhasin Fund earnings for
29 repayment and financing costs upon the recommendation of the Budget and Finance
30

1 Committee and approval by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members of the Navajo
2 Nation Council.

4 **SECTION FOUR. APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF TRANSPORTATION**
5 **IMPROVEMENT EXPENDITURE PLAN ADMINISTRATION**

6 The Navajo Nation Council hereby approves the administration of the Transportation
7 Improvement Expenditure Plan Project as follows:

- 8 A. The Navajo Nation Controller shall determine whether the source of the annual
9 allocations from the Project's total allocation of \$84,000,000 will be Síhasin Fund
10 Principal or Income or a combination of both.
- 11 B. The Síhasin funding for the Project will be distributed to the Navajo DOT in
12 accordance with a disbursement schedule as determined by the Controller in
13 consultation with Navajo DOT. The Navajo DOT shall be responsible for carrying out
14 the Project, in accordance with the Project described in **Exhibit A**.
- 15 C. The Síhasin funds allocated shall be used solely to design, study, plan, construct, re-
16 construct, and acquire machinery as described in **Exhibit A**. Any and all cost-savings
17 shall be returned to the Síhasin Fund once the project is completed.
- 18 D. Funds for the Project that are not spent or encumbered within 36 months of the date
19 funds are made available to Navajo DOT shall revert to the Síhasin Fund principal,
20 unless otherwise recommended by the Resources and Development Committee of the
21 Navajo Nation Council and approved by the Naabik'íyáti' Committee.
- 22 E. Síhasin Funds are excluded from the appropriation lapse provisions in the
23 Appropriations Act pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820(N).
- 24 F. The Project shall be managed by Navajo DOT, and operation, maintenance and repairs
25 for the Project shall be performed by the State of Arizona or NDOT.

26
27 **SECTION FIVE. DIRECTIVES**

28 The Navajo Nation Division of Transportation shall report the status of the Project to the
29 Resources and Development Committee and to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee on a quarterly
30 basis.

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SECTION SIX. EFFECTIVE DATE

The Road Improvement Expenditure Plan, as set forth above, shall become effective pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 2505.

SECTION SEVEN. SAVING CLAUSE

Should any provision(s) of this Act be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the remainder of the Act shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.
