RELATING TO THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE; APPROVING
AND ADOPTING THE NAVAJO NATION 2026 STATE OF UTAH
LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

WHEREAS:

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Naabik'iyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered Naabik'iyáti' Committee to assist and coordinate all requests for information, appearances and testimony relating to proposed county, state and federal legislation impacting the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 700 (A) and 701(A)(6).
- B. The Navajo Utah Commission ("NUC") is established within the Legislative Branch of the Navajo Nation and is subject to oversight of the Navajo Nation Council Naabik'iyáti' Committee, pursuant to Resolution No. NABIAP-21-15.
- C. Through Resolution No. NUCJAN-998-26, the NUC, for and on behalf of the Navajo Nation Chapters located in the State of Utah, approves and recommends to the Navajo Nation, the 2026 Navajo Nation Legislative Priorities for the State of Utah Legislative Session, attached and incorporated herein as **Exhibit A**.

1 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

2 The Navajo Nation hereby approves the Navajo Nation's legislative priorities relating to the
3 State of Utah for 2026, attached as **Exhibit A**, and authorizes the Navajo Nation President, the
4 Navajo Nation Speaker, and their designees, to advocate the position of the Navajo Nation
5 with the State of Utah for the preservation of funding and policies in the Navajo Nation's
6 priority areas.
