

AN ACTION

RELATING TO HEALTH, EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICES AND
NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES; CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF DR.
VINCENT WERITO TO THE NAVAJO TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY BOARD OF
REGENTS REPRESENTING THE EASTERN NAVAJO AGENCY FOR A TERM
OF FOUR YEARS

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council and has oversight of the Navajo Nation Board of Education, and colleges within the Navajo Nation, and has the authority to review and recommend resolutions relating to education in accordance with 2 N.N.C. § 401(B)(6)(a) and (C)(3).
- B. The President of the Navajo Nation shall appoint the five members of the Navajo Technical University Board of Regents who represent the five agencies of the Navajo Nation, subject to confirmation by the Naabik'iyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 15 N.N.C. § 1204 (B).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

1 A. Pursuant to 15 N.N.C. § 1204(A), the Navajo Technical University (“Corporation”) shall
2 be governed by a Board of Regents composed of six members. There shall be one
3 member of the board appointed from each of the five agencies of the Navajo Nation.
4 These five Board members shall have experience in the fields of education, business,
5 science or technology or any other related field, and at a minimum, a bachelor’s degree.
6 The President of the Student Senate of the Navajo Technical University shall serve as a
7 member of the Board by virtue of his/her office and shall be a voting member of the
8 Board.

9 B. Pursuant to 15 N.N.C. § 1204 (C), Board members shall serve terms of four years each,
10 with the exception of the President of the Student Senate, who shall serve as a board
11 member by virtue of his/her office. The terms shall be staggered. A Board member shall
12 continue to serve after the formal expiration of the term until a successor has been
13 confirmed by the Naabik’íyáti’ Committee. The appointed Board members’ terms of
14 office shall begin upon their confirmation by the Naabik’íyáti’ Committee. The Board
15 shall notify the President of the Navajo Nation of an approaching vacancy and may
16 recommend to the President of the Navajo Nation persons to fill vacancies on the board.
17 A Board member may be re-appointed to subsequent terms of office.

18 C. The Navajo Nation President Dr. Buu Nygren has appointed Dr. Vincent Werito to serve
19 as a member of the Board of Regents to represent the Eastern Navajo Agency for a term
20 of four years. Dr. Werito’s letter of appointment is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

21 D. Dr. Vincent Werito meets the qualifications as required by 15 N.N.C § 1204 (A). *See*
22 Certificate of Letter of Interest, Résumé, and Certificate of Indian Blood attached hereto
23 as **Exhibits B, C, and D**, respectively.

24 25 **SECTION THREE. CONFIRMING APPOINTMENT**

26 The Navajo Nation hereby finds that Dr. Vincent Werito meets the qualifications set
27 forth in 15 N.N.C. § 1204 (A) and confirms the appointment of Dr. Vincent Werito to serve
28 on the Navajo Technical University Board of Regents as a representative of the Eastern
29 Navajo Agency for a term of four years, effective upon confirmation by the Naabik’íyáti’
30 Committee as set forth in 15 N.N.C. § 1204 (C).
