**VOTE REQUIRED:** 2/3 vote



11 RELATING TO THE LAW AND ORDER COMMITTEE AND THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI'  
12 COMMITTEE, AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; AMENDING NAVAJO

17 BE IT ENACTED:

19 SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

20 A. The Navajo Nation established the Law and Order Committee (LOC) as a Navajo  
21 Nation standing committee and as such empowered LOC to review and make  
22 recommendations to the Navajo Nation Council on proposed Navajo Nation Code  
23 amendments and enactments. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(9), § 600(A), § 601(B)(14).  
24 B. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee is a Standing Committee of the Navajo Nation Council  
25 with the responsibility to review legislation requiring final action by the Navajo  
26 Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §§164(A)(9) and 701(A)(3).  
27 C. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §  
28 102(A).

29  
30 SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

1 A. The Navajo Nation Washington Office (“NNWO”) was established within the  
2 Executive Branch of the Navajo Nation government as an intergovernmental  
3 relations office. 2 N.N.C. § 1150.

4 B. The Navajo Nation is a sovereign government responsible for providing critical  
5 government services to its people.

6 C. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 1152, the NNWO’s Director currently works at the pleasure  
7 of the Navajo Nation President.

8 D. The Navajo Nation Council enacts public policy resolutions that are to communicated  
9 to the federal government by the Navajo Nation Washington Office. By amending 2  
10 N.N.C. § 1152 such that the Navajo Nation Washington Office Director serves at the  
11 pleasure of the Navajo Nation Council, the Navajo Nation Council will have a closer  
12 relationship with the Director to monitor the implementation of the various Navajo  
13 Nation Council policy resolutions.

15 **SECTION THREE. AMENDING 2 N.N.C. § 1152**

16 A. The Navajo Nation Council hereby amends 2 N.N.C. § 1152 as set forth below:

18 **§ 1152. Personnel**

19 B. The Director shall be appointed by the President of the Navajo Nation subject  
20 to confirmation by the Navajo Nation Council; to serve at a negotiated salary  
21 and at the pleasure of the ~~President of the~~ Navajo Nation Council.

23 **SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE**

24 This Action shall become effective in accordance with 2 N.N.C. §221(B).

25

26 **SECTION FIVE. SAVING CLAUSE**

27 If any provision of this Action is determined invalid by the Supreme Court of the Navajo  
28 Nation, or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation  
29 Supreme Court, the remainder of this Action shall be the law of the Navajo Nation.
