**VOTE REQUIRED:** 2/3 vote of the Navajo Nation Council



18 BE IT ENACTED:

19  
20 **SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY**

21 A. The Budget and Finance Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation  
22 Council and has the authority to review and recommend to the Council the budgeting,  
23 appropriation, investment and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §§ 300(A) and  
24 301(B)(2).

25 B. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council  
26 with the authority to hear all proposed resolutions that require final action by the  
27 Council, and serves as the oversight Committee for the offices, programs,  
28 commissions, boards or task forces under the Legislative Branch. 2 N.N.C. §§  
29 164(A)(9), 700(A) and 701(A)(5).

1 C. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §  
2 102(A). As such, the Council “may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to  
3 the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental  
4 appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and  
5 when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue  
6 projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount set forth  
7 at § 820(J).” 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).

8 D. The restrictions on supplemental appropriations, including all amounts from the  
9 Unreserved Undesignated Fund Balance (“UUFB”), include:

10 1. Payment of recurring government operating expenses shall be from recurring  
11 revenues, and payment of nonrecurring expenses shall be from nonrecurring  
12 revenues such as UUFB funds. 12 N.N.C. § 820(E) and (F).

13 2. Specifically, the UUFB shall not be used for recurring government  
14 expenditures or operations. 12 N.N.C. § 820(J) and (L).

15 3. Nonrecurring revenues such as UUFB funds may be used only after the  
16 Controller determines whether or not such revenues are subsidizing an  
17 imbalance between the Navajo Nation’s recurring revenues and expenditures,  
18 and government expenditures shall only be authorized if a long-term (3-year  
19 to 5-year) forecast shows that the operating deficit will not continue;  
20 otherwise, nonrecurring revenues will be added to the UUFB. 12 N.N.C. §  
21 820(F).

22 4. The above provisions in Title 12 may be amended or waived by a two-thirds  
23 vote of the full Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 820(F).

24 5. In compliance with 12 N.N.C. § 820(F), all UUFB funding requests must be  
25 reviewed by the Controller. Such review is also required because the  
26 Controller determines which revenues and expenses are recurring and which  
27 are non-recurring. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).

28 6. In compliance with 12 N.N.C. § 820(B) and (M), all UUFB funding requests  
29 must be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget (“OMB”) for a  
30 budget impact analysis.

1           7. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(N)(4), UUFB appropriations revert to the  
2           General Fund at the end of the fiscal year unless the Navajo Nation Council  
3           waives such reversion by a 7/8 vote.

5 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS.**

6           A. The line-item vetoes in Navajo Nation Council Resolutions CS-44-25, CS-45-25, and  
7           CN-56-25 have left the Legislative Branch unable to operate without additional  
8           funding.

9           B. The Office of the Speaker (“OOS”) is requesting \$3,684,574 in supplemental funding  
10           from the UUFB to fund operations for nine Legislative Branch programs for the  
11           remainder of Fiscal Year 2026 (“FY 2026”).

12           C. The OOS has provided the required Navajo Nation budget forms, along with the  
13           Appendix J - Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary. Budget Forms are attached  
14           as **Exhibit A**.

15           D. The Office of the Controller provided a memorandum as required by 12 N.N.C.  
16           §820(L), indicating that the proposed expenditures are recurring. The Controller’s  
17           memorandum is attached as **Exhibit B**.

18           E. The Office of Management and Budget provided its memorandum as required by 12  
19           N.N.C. §820(M). The OMB memorandum is attached as **Exhibit C**.

21 **SECTION THREE. APPROVAL OF \$3,684,574 FROM THE UUFB FOR NINE**  
22 **LEGISLATIVE BRANCH PROGRAMS TO FUND OPERATIONS FOR THE**  
23 **REMAINDER OF FY 2026**

24           A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves supplemental appropriation in the amount of  
25           \$3,684,574 from the Unreserved Undesignated Fund Balance for the Legislative  
26           Branch to fund operations for the remainder of FY 2026, in accordance with the  
27           attached **Exhibit A**.

28           B. This supplemental appropriation approved herein shall be from those funds that exceed  
29           the minimum fund reserve balance of the Unreserved Undesignated Fund Balance  
30           required by 12 N.N.C. § 820(J).

1 C. Upon the effective date of this resolution, the approved Unreserved Undesignated Fund  
2 Balance funds shall be promptly transferred into those budget line items listed in the  
3 attached **Exhibit A**.

4 D. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(N), any amount of the \$3,684,574 approved herein that  
5 remains unspent or unencumbered at the end of FY 2026 shall revert to the General  
6 Fund, unless Council waives such reversion by a 7/8 vote prior to the date in which the  
7 funds are scheduled to revert.

9 **SECTION FOUR. WAIVING 12 N.N.C. § 820(E), (F), (J), and (L)**

10 The Navajo Nation hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §820(E), (F), (J), and (L) to the extent it will  
11 allow Unreserved Undesignated Fund Balance funds to be used for Legislative Branch's  
12 recurring expenditures for FY 2026.

13 **SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE**

14 This Action shall become effective in accordance with 2 N.N.C. §221(B) and 2 N.N.C.  
15 §164(A)(17).

16 **SECTION SIX. SAVING CLAUSE**

17 If any portion of this Action is determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or  
18 by a District Court of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme  
19 Court, the remainder of this Action shall be the law of the Navajo Nation.
