VOTE REQUIRED: Simple Majority


This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

20 SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- 21 A. The Naabik'iyáti Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council
22 and has legislative oversight over the Commission on Navajo Government
23 Development and is empowered to recommend all resolutions to the Navajo Nation
24 Council on matters with the Committee's jurisdiction pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §§
25 700(A), 701(A)(3), and 970.
26 B. The Navajo Nation Council confirms appointments to the Commission on Navajo
27 Government Development. 2 N.N.C. § 972(A).

29 SECTION TWO. FINDINGS
30

- 1 A. The Commission on Navajo Government Development is established within the
2 Legislative Branch as a special entity created by the Navajo Nation Council with
3 quasi-independent authority to accomplish the People's project of instituting reforms
4 necessary to ensure accountability, responsibility, ethical, and an equally
5 representative government. 2 N.N.C. § 970.
- 6 B. The Commission shall consist of 12 Navajo members to be confirmed by and serve
7 at the pleasure of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 972(A).
- 8 C. Five members shall be nominated from the five agencies of the Navajo Nation. Each
9 agency council shall nominate one member from recommendations to be submitted
10 by Chapters on each agency, said nominees shall be either Chapter officers, Local
11 Government/Governance Commissioners, Grazing Committee/Land Board
12 members, or School Board members. These members shall serve a term of four years
13 from the date of confirmation by the Navajo Nation Council, so long as they continue
14 as Chapter officers, Local Government/Governance Commissioners, Grazing
15 Committee/Land Board member, or School Board member. 2 N.N.C. § 972(A)(5).
- 16 D. Commission members shall be chosen from among individuals who have
17 demonstrated scholarship, a strong sense of civic interest, knowledge of Diné history
18 and cultural heritage, spiritual leadership, leadership in the Navajo government and
19 abilities likely to contribute to the fulfillment of the duties of the commission. 2
20 N.N.C. § 972(D).
- 21 E. The Central Agency Council nominates and recommends Dr. Dolly Manson to serve
22 on the Commission on Navajo Government Development pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §
23 972(A)(5). Central Agency Council Resolution CNAC25-04-07 is attached as
24 **Exhibit A.**
- 25 F. Dr. Dolly Manson's letter of interest and resumé are attached as **Exhibit B.**
