PURPOSE: This resolution, if approved, would amend the Plan of Operation for the Navajo Nation Band Program.



17 SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

18 A. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is a standing committee of
19 the Navajo Nation Council and serves as the oversight for the Division of Human
20 Resources with the authority to review, recommend or propose the adoption,
21 amendment, or rescission of its Plan of Operation. 2 N.N.C. §§ 400(A) and
22 401(C)(1).

24 SECTION TWO. FINDINGS.

- 25 A. The Navajo Nation Band Program (“NNBP”) operates under the Division of
26 Human Resources to promote the Navajo Nation through participation in organized
27 musical and performing arts activities
- 28 B. The NNBP was established under Resolution ACMY-196-71 with the most recent
29 amendment to its Plan of Operation under Resolution HEHSCD-043-13.
