17 SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

18 The Law and Order Committee is established as a standing committee of the Navajo Nation
19 Council. 2 N.N.C. § 600 (A).

21 SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- 22 A. The Charter of the Navajo Nation Oil and Gas Corporation at Article V (D) states
23 “All rights of the shareholder of the Corporation shall by the appointed shareholder
24 representatives, composed of one member from each of the standing committees of
25 the Navajo Nation Council or their successor committees”
26 B. Standing committees are required to select a member from each committee to serve
27 as a shareholder representative of the Navajo Nation Oil and Gas Corporation.
28 C. Through Resolution LOCMY-02-23, the Law and Order Committee appointed
29 Delegate Steven Arviso to serve as shareholder representative to the Navajo Nation
30 Oil and Gas Corporation.

1 D. Steven Arviso, having resigned his position, is no longer a Delegate of the Navajo
2 Nation Council, leaving the Law and Order Committee without a shareholder
3 representative to the Navajo Nation Oil and Gas Corporation.

4 E. The Law and Order Committee is required to appoint a member of their committee
5 to serve as a shareholder representative to the Navajo Nation Oil and Gas
6 Corporation.

8 **SECTION THREE. APPOINTING A LAW AND ORDER COMMITTEE**
9 **MEMBER AS A SHAREHOLDER REPRESENTATIVE TO THE NAVAJO**
10 **NATION OIL AND GAS CORPORATION.**

11 Honorable Delegate _____, a member of the
12 Navajo Nation Law and Order Standing Committee, is hereby appointed to serve as a
13 shareholder representative to the Navajo Nation Oil and Gas Corporation.
