- Attach an electronic copy of the proposed resolution ***in MS Word format***.
- The presenter is responsible for ***bringing 40 hard copies*** of the draft resolution to the meeting for distribution.

For Quarterly Reports & Updates:

- Send an email with the subject matter of your report/update.
- Identify the Presenter(s) by name and title.
- Attach the report/update in PDF format.
- The presenter is responsible for bringing 40 copies of the report/update to the meeting for distribution.
- Please note there is a ***10-minute*** time limit for each report/update.

The deadline for all submissions is Friday, July 3, 2026 at **5:00 PM.**

A draft meeting agenda will be available on or before Wednesday, July 8, 2026.
