Law and Order Committee announces public hearing on proposed Title 17 Amendments and additional locations

WINDOW ROCK, Ariz. — The Law and Order Committee is inviting the public to attend a series of hearings regarding proposed amendments to Title 17 of the Navajo Nation Code, which governs criminal law.

The public hearings will provide an opportunity for community members to share input, ask questions, and help shape legislation that impacts public safety and the administration of justice across the Navajo Nation. The proposed amendments are intended to strengthen protections for Navajo people and improve the effectiveness of the Nation's criminal justice system.

Each public hearing will be held following the Committee's regular meeting, beginning at 10:00 a.m.
