VOTE REQUIRED: Simple Majority

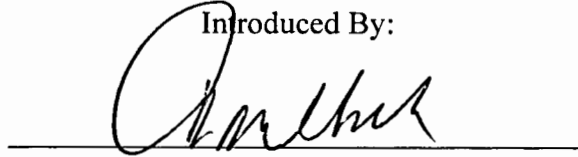
This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

RELATING TO LAW AND ORDER AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES,
AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; CONFIRMING AND CONSENTING
TO THE APPOINTMENT OF DELORES GREYEYES AS THE NAVAJO
DIVISION OF PUBLIC SAFETY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Law and Order Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council with oversight authority over the Navajo Division of Public Safety. 2 N.N.C. §§ 600(A), 601 (C)(1), and 1355.
- B. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council with the authority to hear proposed resolutions requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2. N.N.C. §§164 (A)(9), 700 (A) and 701 (A)(3).
- C. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation and shall confirm the appointments of all division directors upon recommendation from the appropriate oversight committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 102 (A) and (F) *see also* 2 N.N.C. §1353.

1 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

- 2 A. The Navajo Nation President appoints Delores Greyeyes, Ph.D., as the Navajo
3 Division of Public Safety Executive Director. Dr. Greyeyes' appointment letter and
4 resume are attached as **EXHIBIT A**.
- 5 B. The Navajo Nation Council confirms and consents to the Navajo Division of Public
6 Safety Executive Director. 2 N.N.C. §§102(F) and 1353.
- 7 C. The Navajo Division of Public Safety Executive Director serves at the pleasure of the
8 Navajo Nation President. 2 N.N.C. §1353.

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10 **SECTION THREE. CONFIRMATION**

- 11 A. The Navajo Nation Council confirms and consents to Dr. Delores Greyeyes as the
12 Navajo Division of Public Safety Executive Director.
- 13 B. Dr. Greyeyes shall serve at the pleasure of the Navajo Nation President, and her term
14 shall run concurrent with the Navajo Nation President Buu Van Nygren's term.
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
